Online Kindergarten Enrollment is currently open for the 2024-2025 school year. The enrollment process is for students who are new to the district. Students who are currently attending our Early Start or Early Childhood programs are already enrolled and do not need to complete this process. In April registration for the 2024-2025 school year will open up for all students, including incoming Kindergarten students. Registration is the process of confirming student information and attendance for the 2024-2025 school year, and the collection of student fees.
