Mike,

Do you know where the instruments are going to be stored this summer and how they will get there? Also, when will they be moved and who is doing the moving?

Here are my thoughts for the stuff in my room.

Piano - we'll just leave it here and try to get it tuned right at the beginning of the school year. Unless you want to store it somewhere else.

Guitars - I have 3 acoustics and 2 electrics. I think I have cases for the acoustics, I do not for the electrics. I can just bring home the electrics. The acoustics can be stored with the ukuleles.

Keyboards - I will remove all of the batteries and they can stay in the cabinets. I think they'll be ok.

Ukuleles - I do have cases for all of those, but some are really thin. I am most concerned about those, since I know those cases won't protect a lot. I would move them myself, but there are 87 of them... that would be a lot of trips! But, if we know where they're going and I can do that during the 8th grade class time that last week (8th graders are gone that week). If they are just going across town, I can try to do that then.

Do we know where everything is being stored?

I still have classes on 5/21 7:50-9:15 and 12:15-1:45. But, I have time in the middle of that day where I can help bring out things from my classroom.
