

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE TERMINATION OF THE BOYS AND GIRLS WRESTLING COOPERATIVE
SPONSORSHIP AGREEMENT BETWEEN GREENWAY PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICT AND
NASHWAUK-KEEWATIN SCHOOL DISTRICT

WHEREAS, Greenway Public School District and Nashwauk-Keewatin School District have participated in a cooperative sponsorship agreement for the purpose of offering an interscholastic boys and girls wrestling program to students of both districts; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education recognizes the value and importance of providing interscholastic athletic opportunities for students and remains committed to supporting participation in boys and girls wrestling; and

WHEREAS, both districts have evaluated their current and future programmatic needs, enrollment trends, and participation opportunities; and

WHEREAS, representatives of both districts have engaged in discussions regarding the future structure of boys and girls wrestling opportunities available to their respective students; and

WHEREAS, both districts intend to continue offering boys and girls wrestling as an extracurricular activity and desire to pursue alternative cooperative arrangements that better align with the needs and interests of their students and athletic programs; and

WHEREAS, the Minnesota State High School League requires school boards to formally approve the establishment or termination of cooperative sponsorship agreements;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the School Board of Greenway Public School District, as follows:

1. The School Board hereby approves the termination of the existing Boys & Girls Wrestling Cooperative Sponsorship Agreement between Greenway Public School District and Nashwauk-Keewatin School District.
2. The termination shall be effective with the conclusion of the 2025-2026 school year and prior to the commencement of the 2026-2027 Minnesota State High School League season.
3. The School Board affirms its commitment to continuing boys and girls wrestling opportunities for Greenway students and authorizes district administration to pursue and negotiate a new cooperative sponsorship arrangement, subject to School Board approval and Minnesota State High School League requirements.
4. The Superintendent and other appropriate district officials are authorized to take all necessary actions and submit all required documentation to implement this resolution and facilitate an orderly transition.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the School Board expresses its appreciation to Nashwauk-Keewatin School District, its students, coaches, administrators, and community members for their partnership and collaboration throughout the duration of the Wrestling cooperative sponsorship agreement.
