SUBJECT: Annual Review of Safety Hazard Conditions

RECOMMENDATION: The Administration recommends that the Board of Education approve the Resolution to Continue Hazardous Busing.

BACKGROUND DATA: Annually, the Board of Education is required to review and certify the existence of hazardous conditions that have previously been submitted to and approved by the Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT). Included in BoardBook is the required Resolution to Continue Hazardous Busing, which includes a list of the hazardous locations. The listing of hazardous locations is organized by school and sorted by application number. Also included in BoardBook is a PDF portfolio of all the Serious Safety Hazard Finding Submittals. The submittals provide the Board with maps that identify the locations of the hazardous areas. The submittals also include the rationale behind the finding.

FINANCIAL IMPACT: Continued approval of hazardous areas allows for transportation aid to be claimed for students in the area.

SUGGESTED MOTION: That the Board of Education approve the resolution certifying that hazardous conditions continue to exist in the areas cited in the resolution and that the busing of students from these areas should continue for the 2026-2027 school year.
