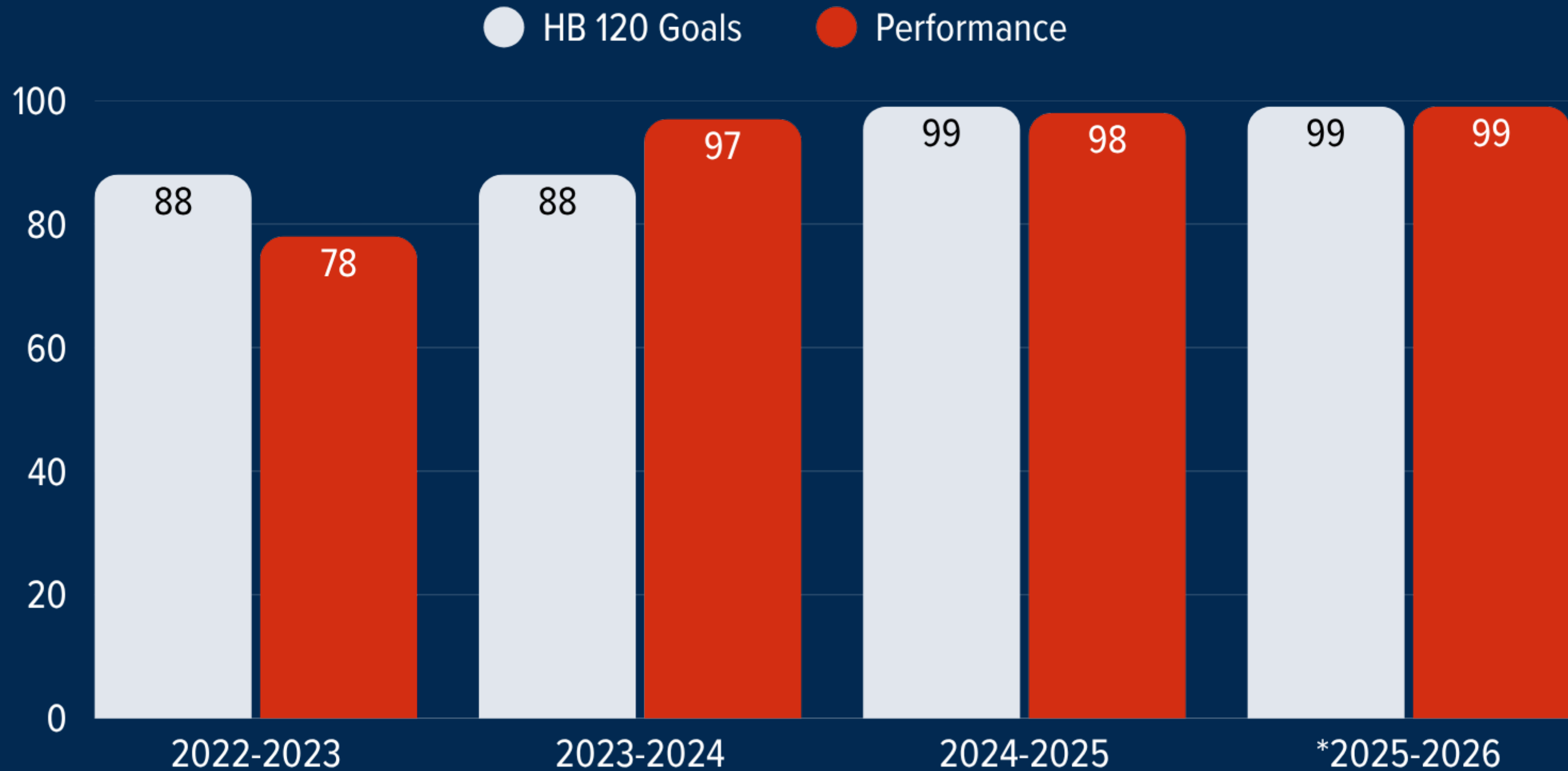

CCMR District Performance

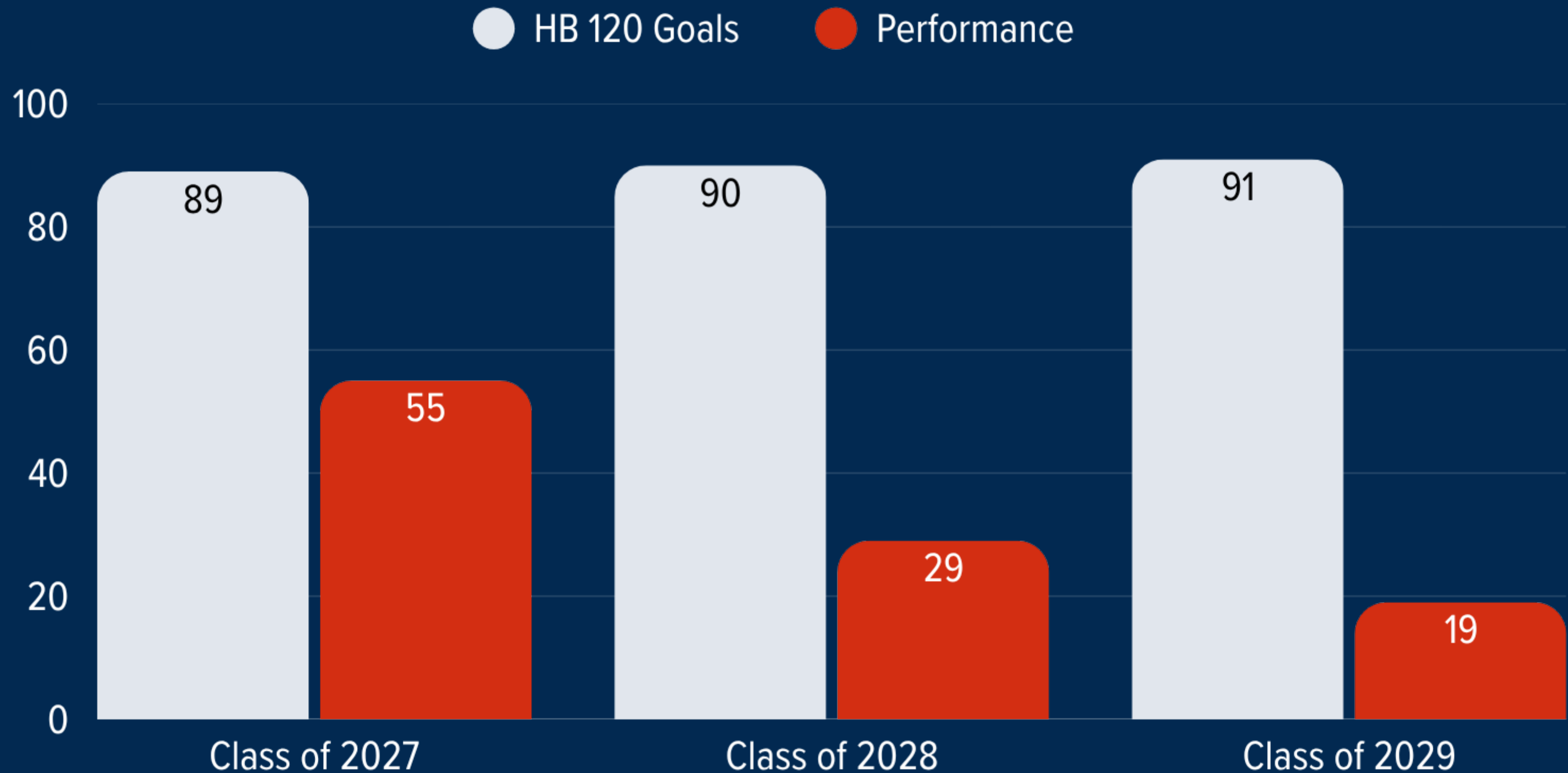

CCMR District Performance

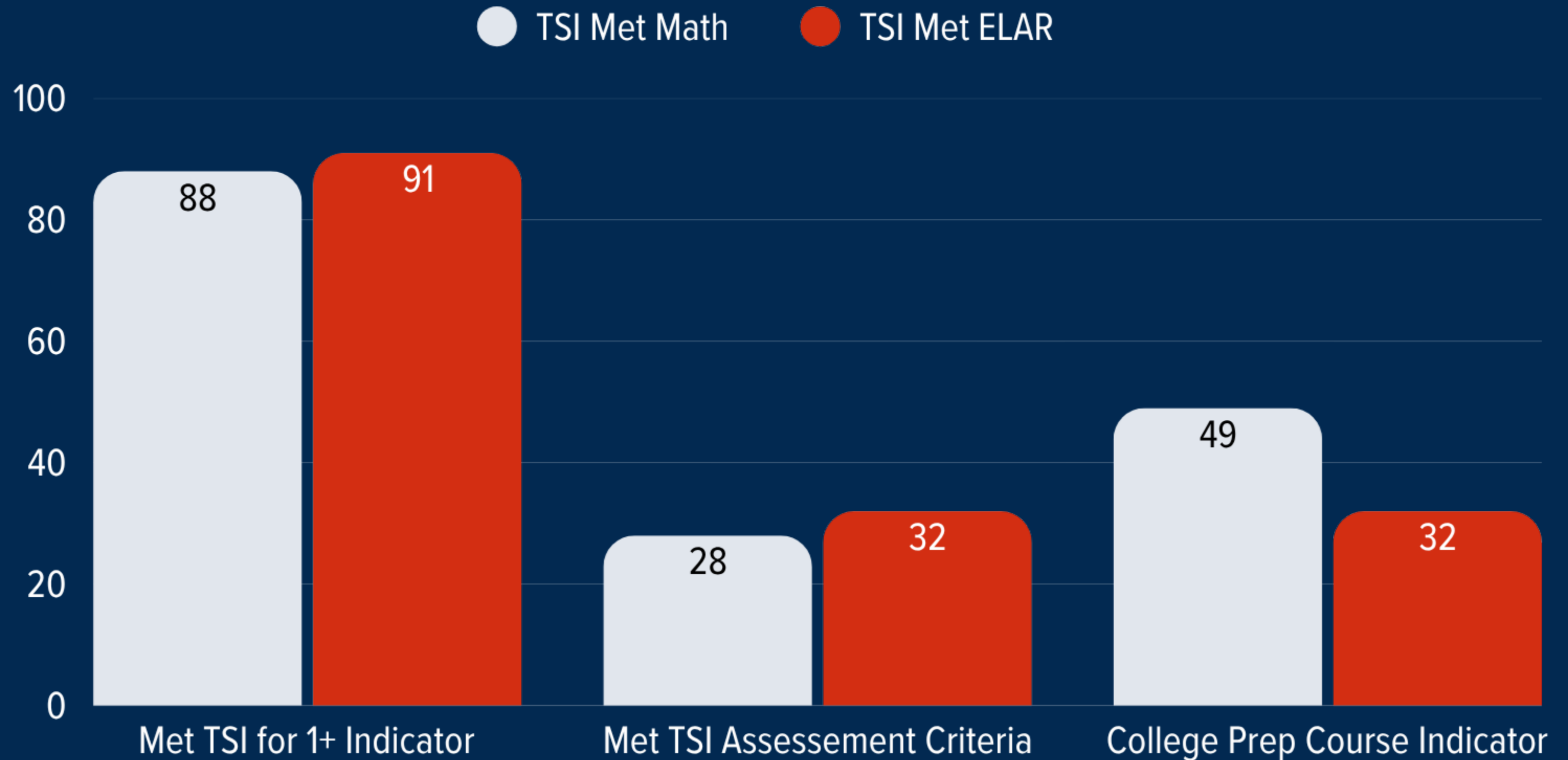


Class of 2027 and beyond is estimated data

STRATEGIC PLANNING: ELAR

IMPACT OF COLLEGE PREPARATION COURSES:

College Prep English:

- The number of students meeting CCMR has risen from 1% in 2023 to 32% in 2025.



MISD PROACTIVE RESPONSE:

College Prep English:

- A new partnership with Hill College. This course is taught by MISD teachers using an aligned curriculum to better prepare students for success on the TSIA.



STRATEGIC PLANNING: MATH

IMPACT OF COLLEGE PREPARATION COURSES:

College Prep Math:

- The number of students meeting CCMR has risen from 16% in 2023 to 49% in 2025.



MISD PROACTIVE RESPONSE:

College Prep Math:

- Select students will have the opportunity to enroll in OnRamps Math as a way to demonstrate college readiness.
- **Curriculum Alignment:** The math department is aligning curriculum documents with the TSIA test objectives.



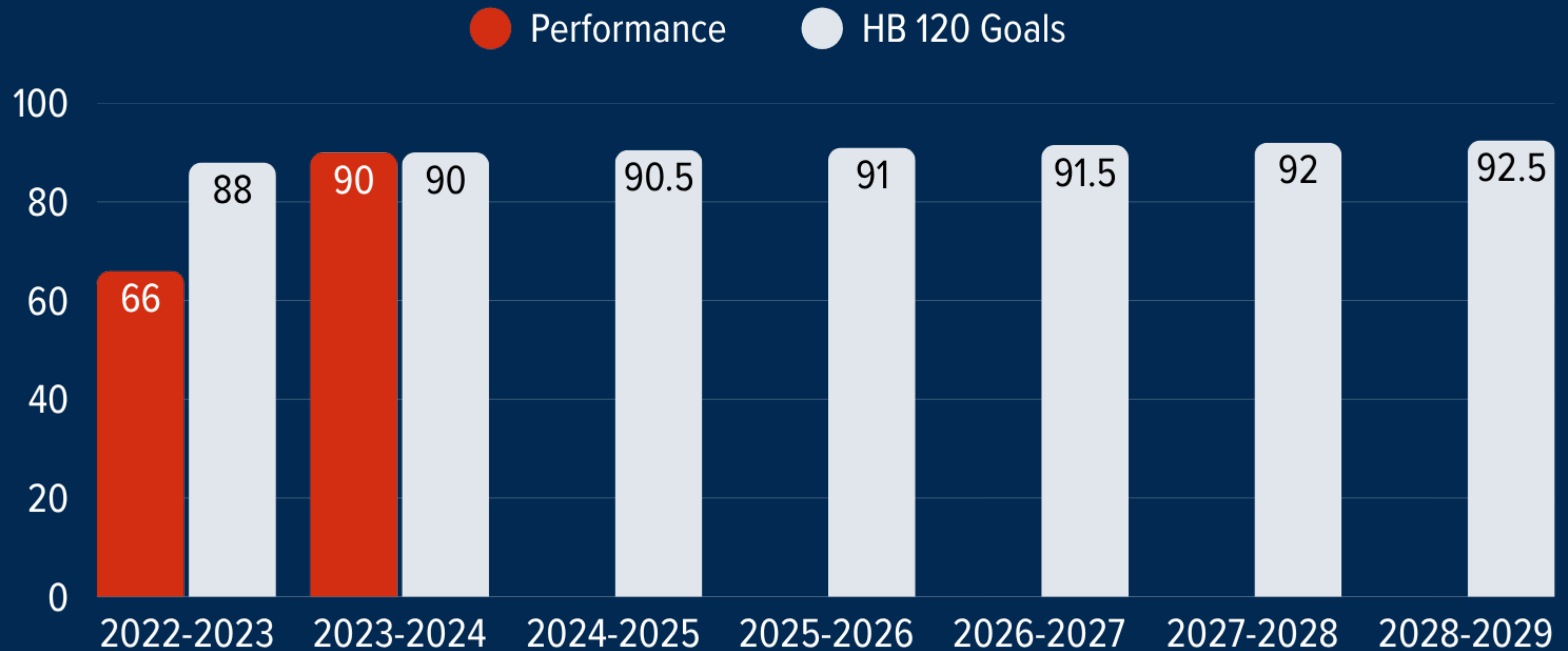

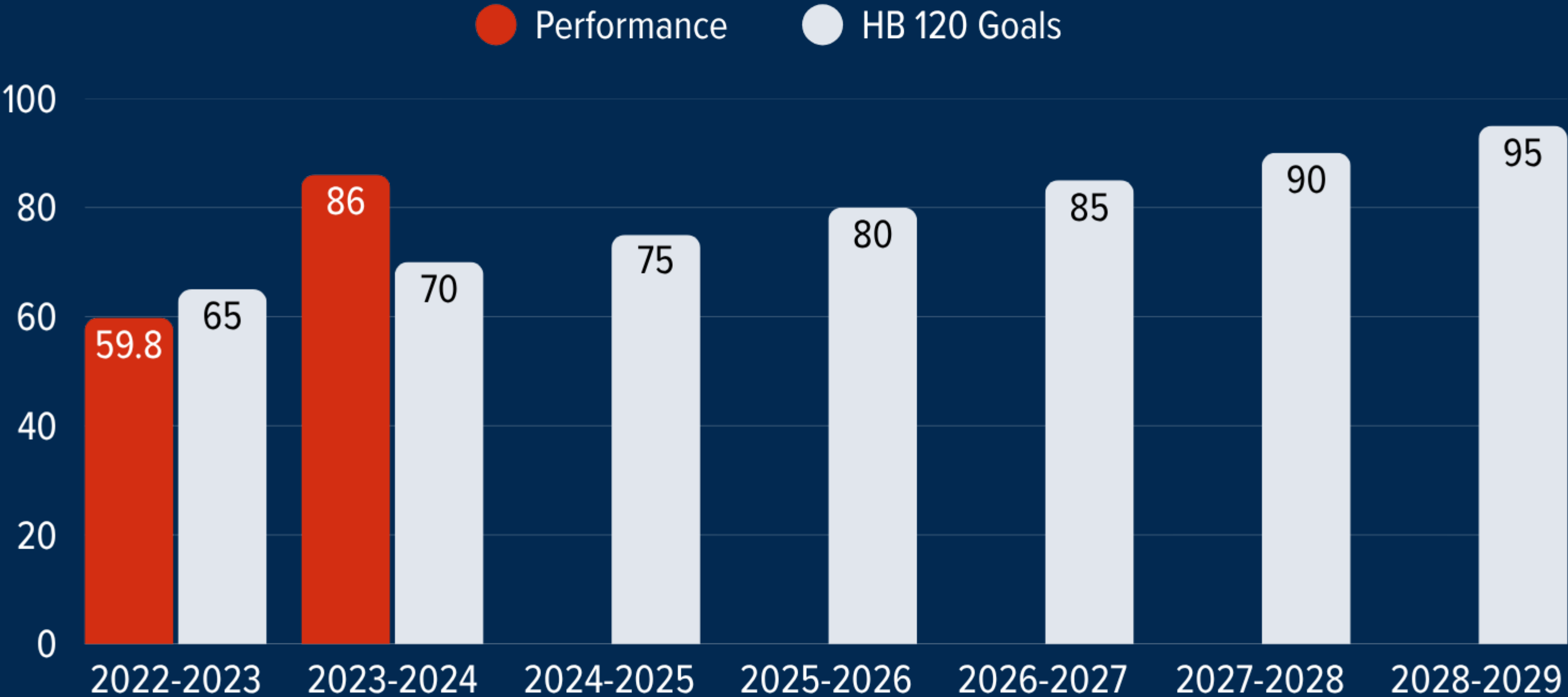
COLLEGE READINESS GOALS

% of College Ready Graduates



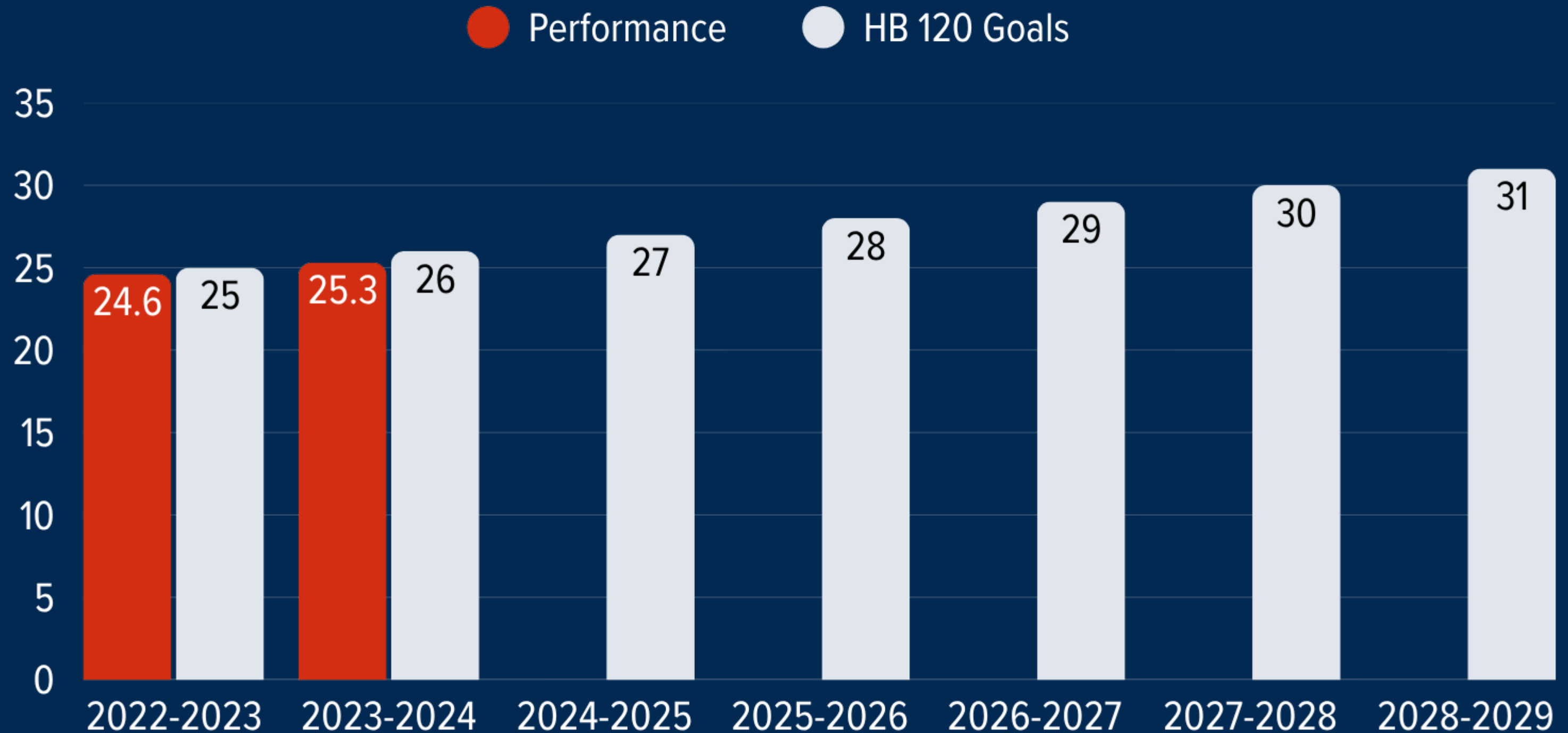
TEXAS SUCCESS INITIATIVE (TSI)

% of Graduates that meet CCMR through TSIA/SAT/ACT/College Prep



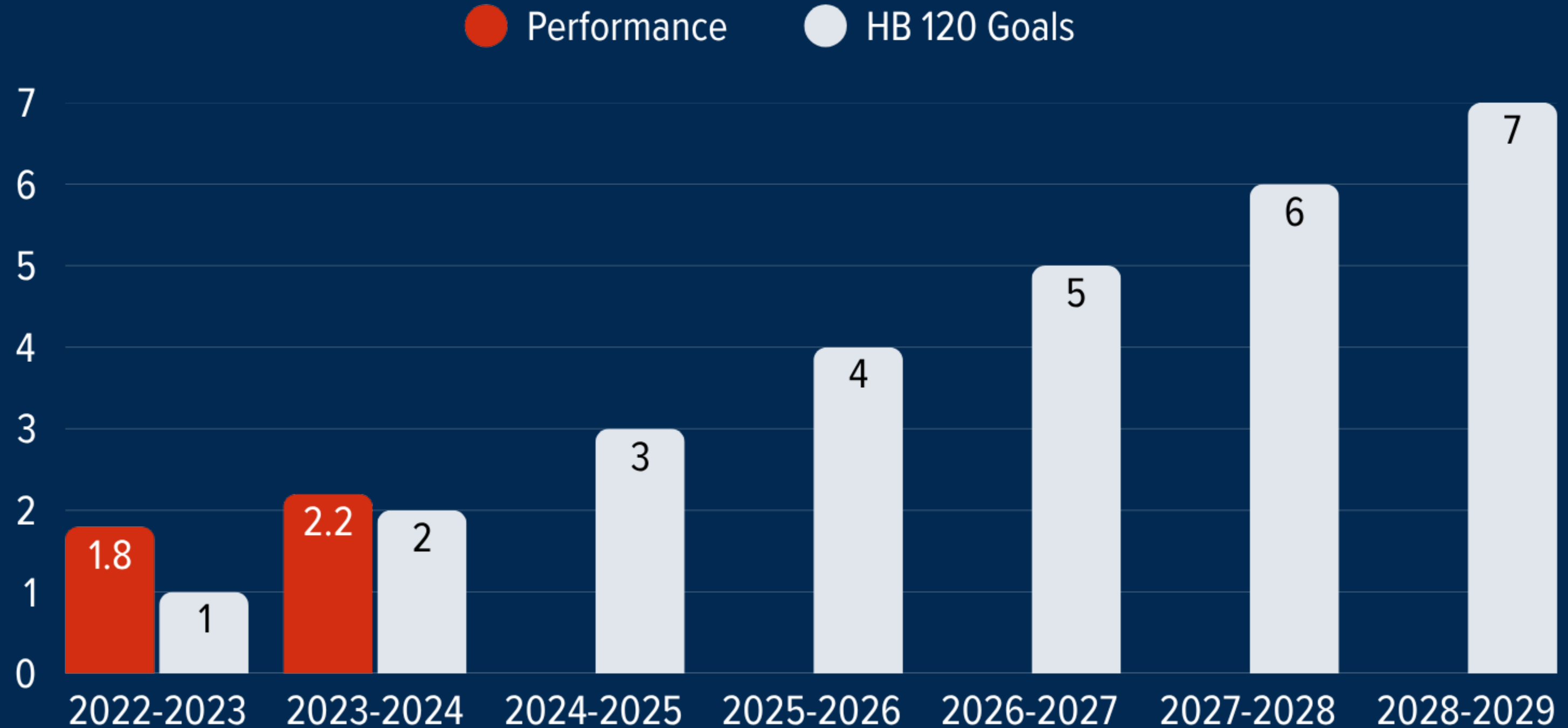
ADVANCED PLACEMENT (AP)

% of Graduates that meet CCMR by earning 3+ on AP Exam



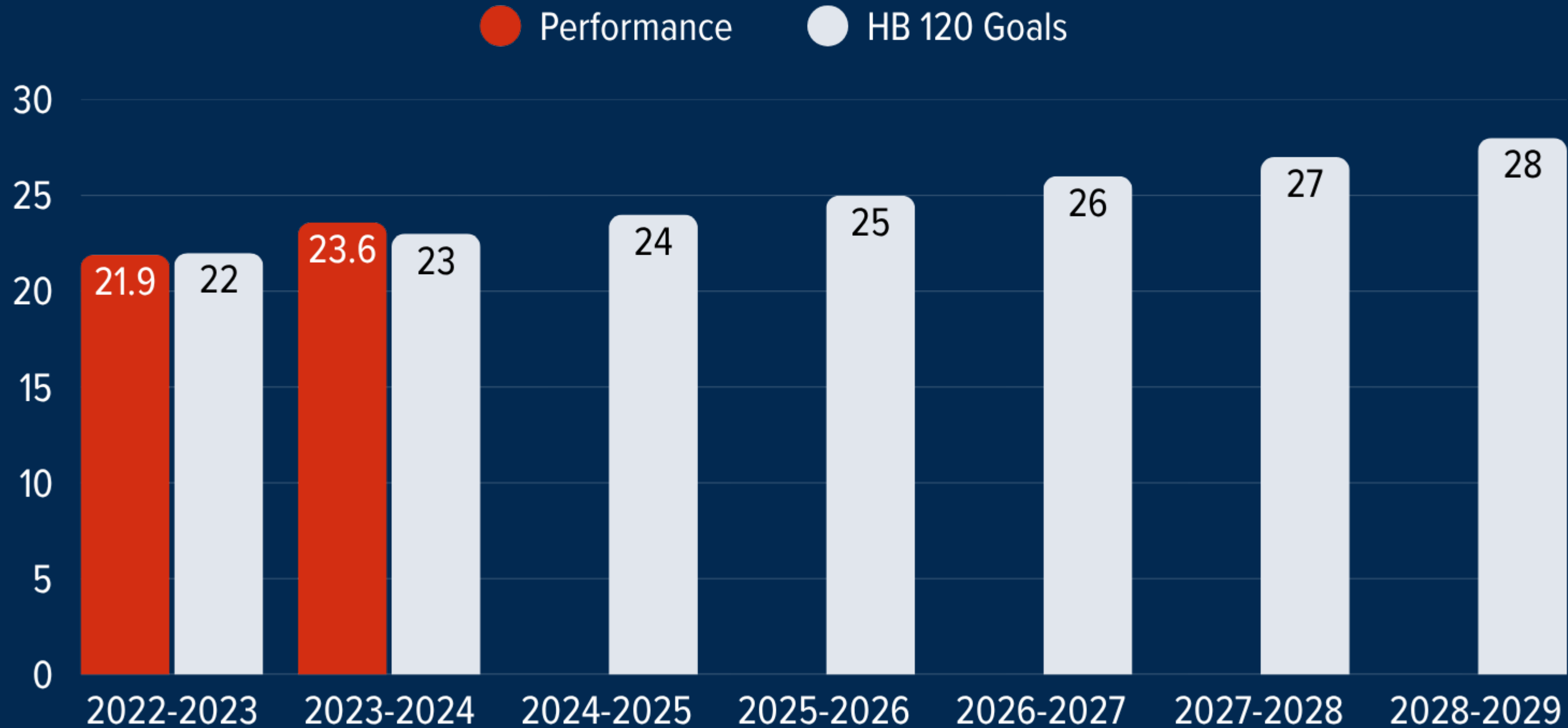
ASSOCIATE DEGREE

% of Graduates that meet CCMR through dual credit



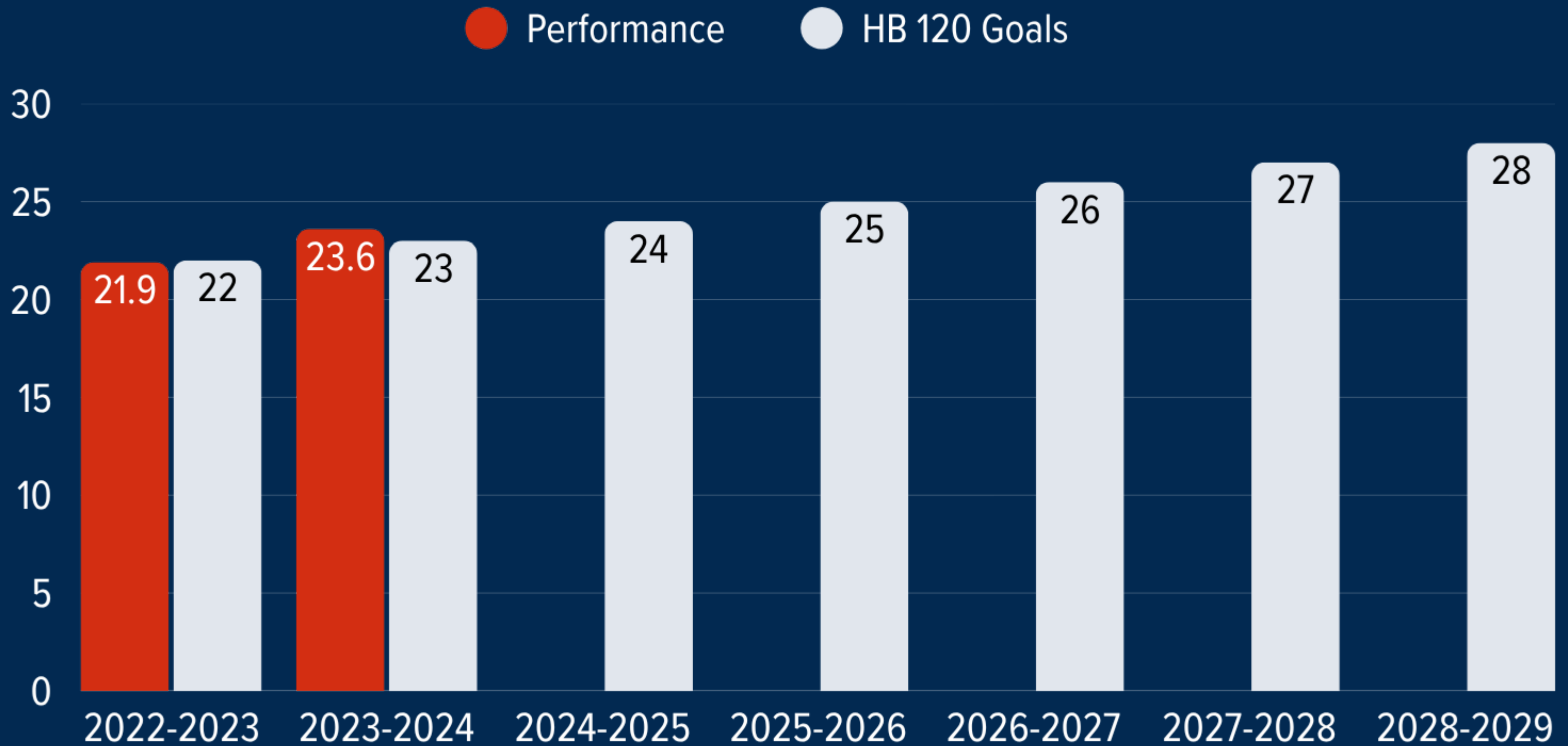
ON RAMPS

% of Graduates that meet CCMR through OnRamps



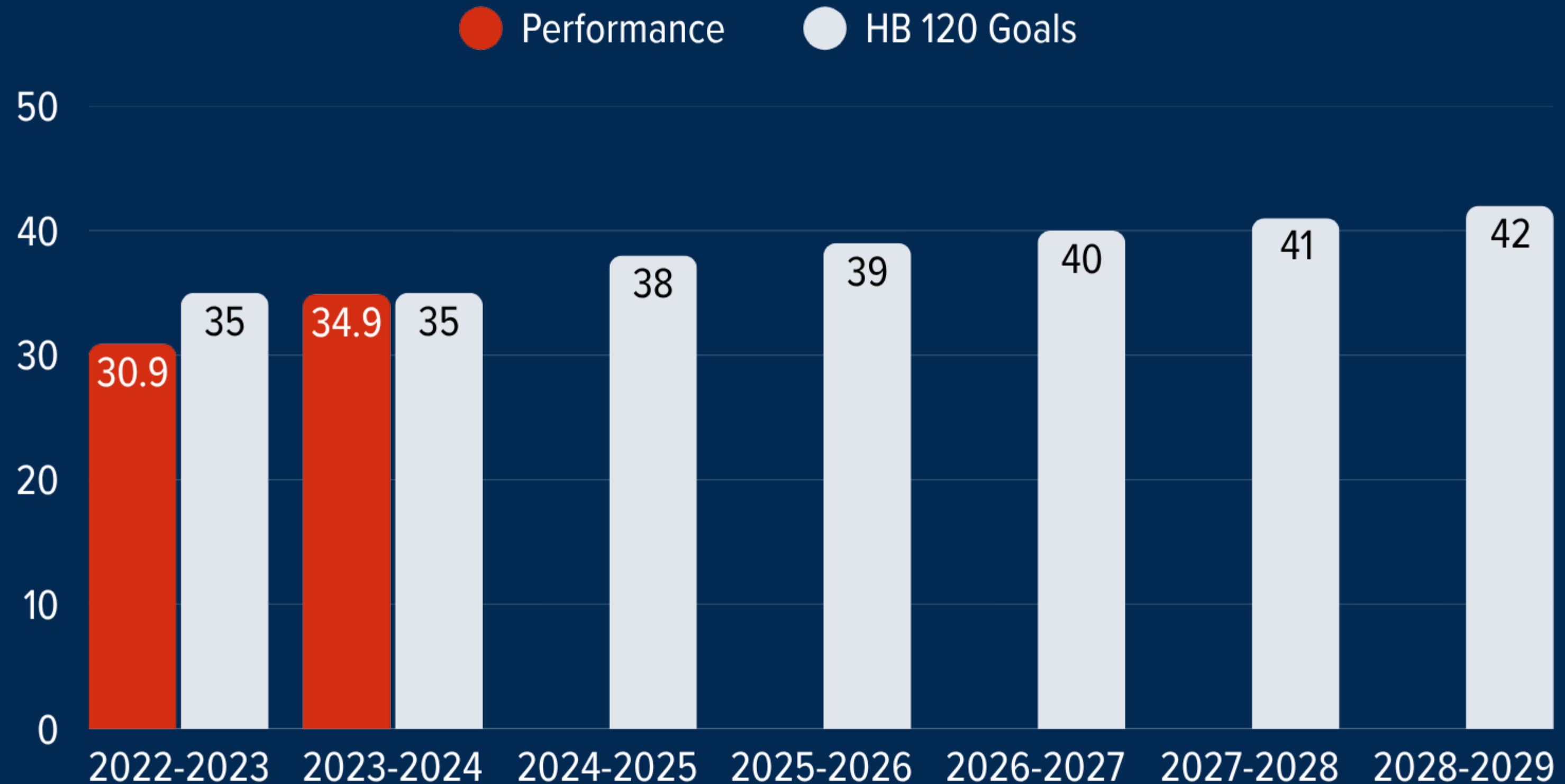
ADVANCED DIPLOMA PLAN

% of Graduates that meet CCMR through dual credit



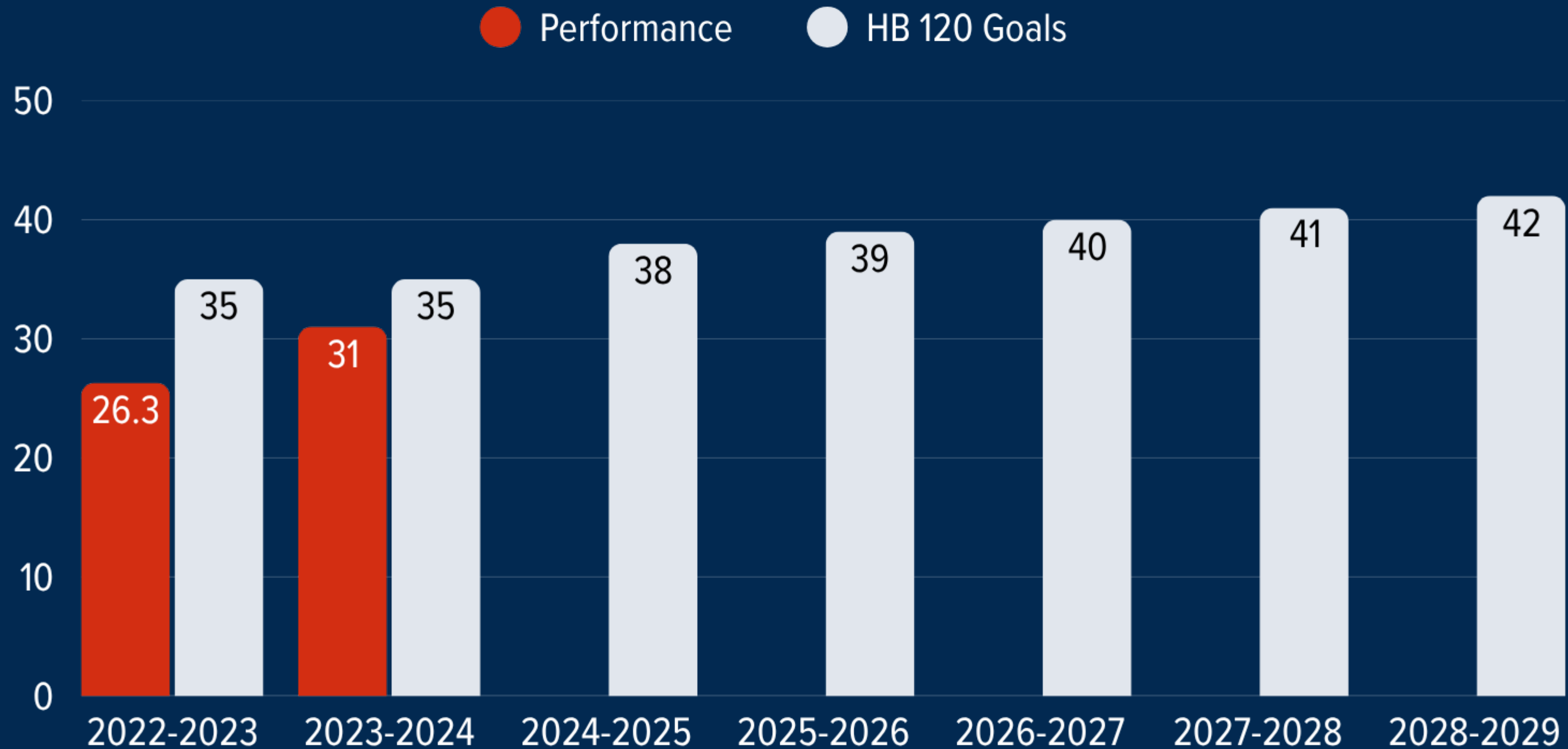
CAREER/MILITARY READINESS GOALS

% of Graduates earning an Industry Based Certification



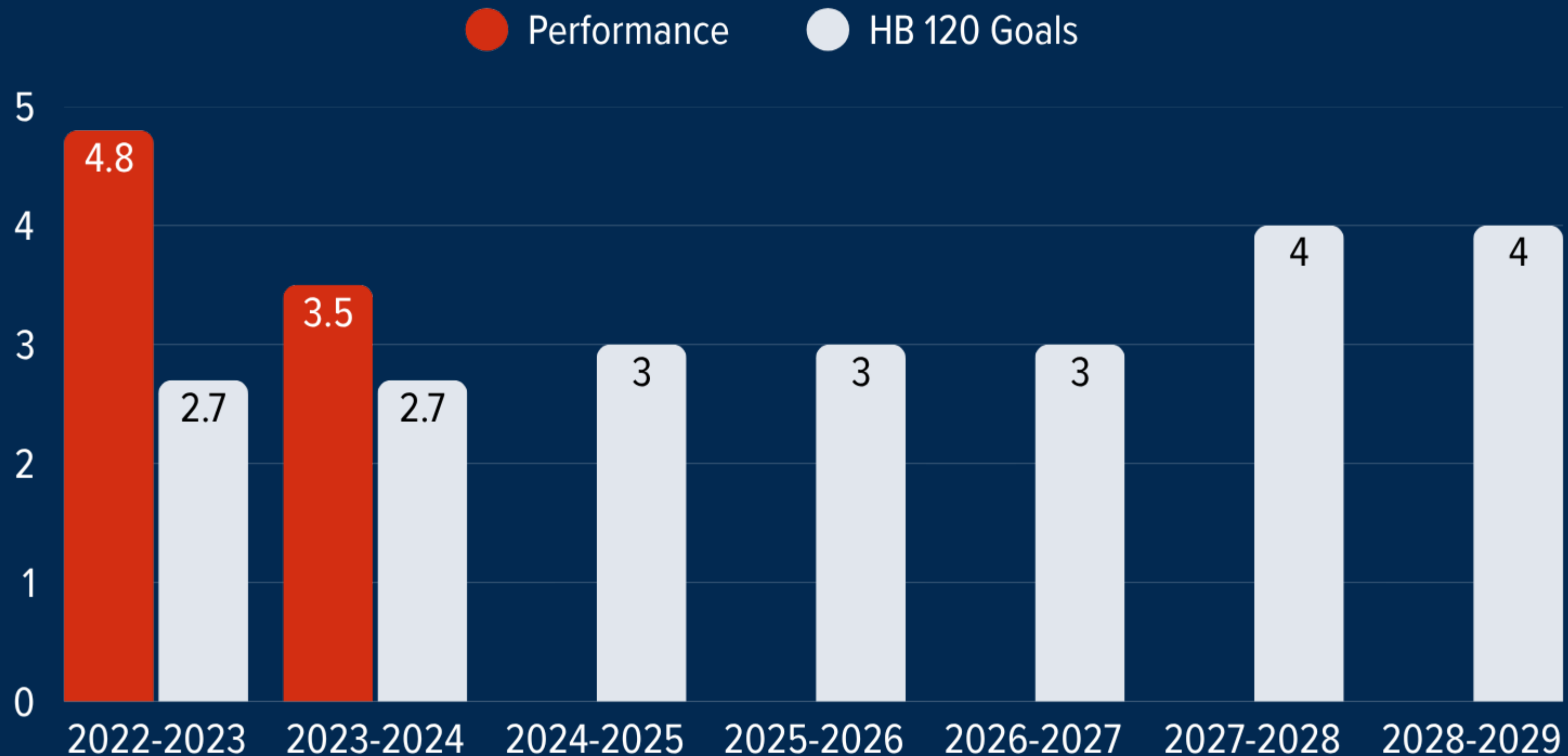
LEVEL I AND LEVEL II CERTIFICATES

% of Graduates with Completed IEP and Workforce Readiness



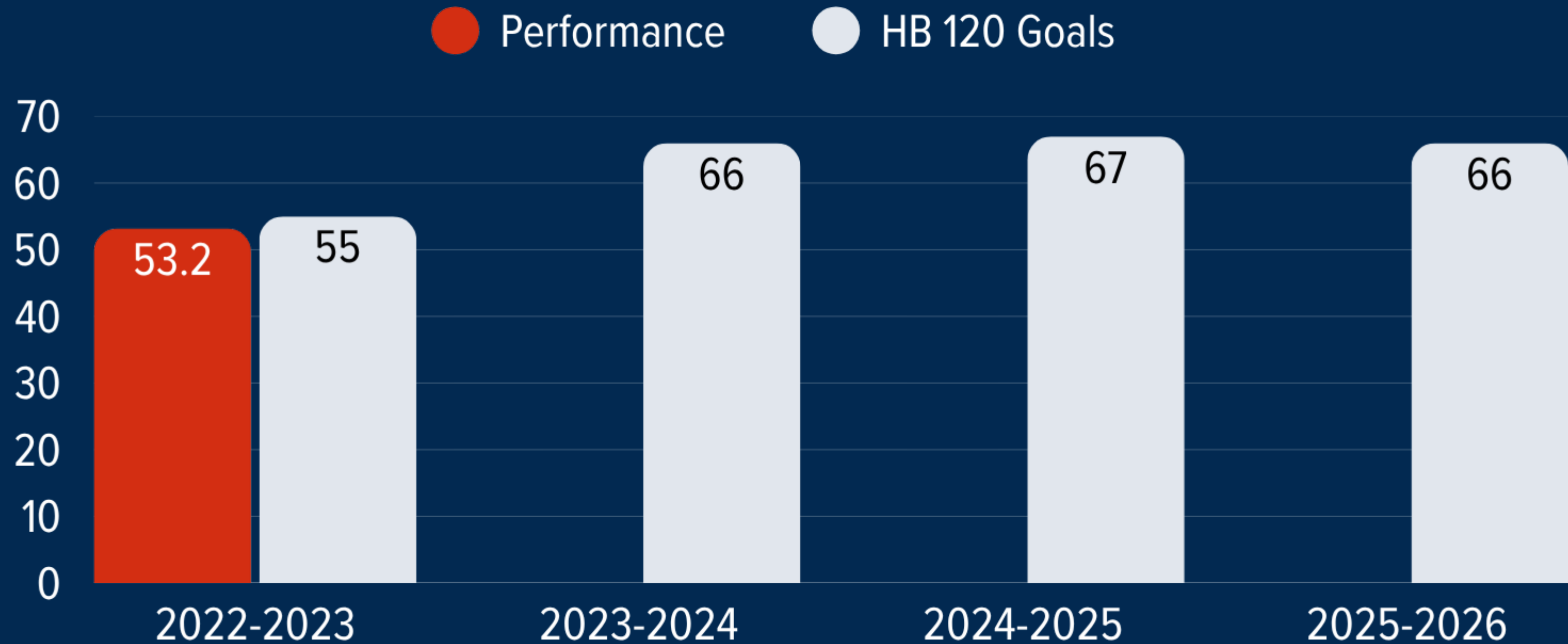
MILITARY ENLISTMENT

Graduates enrolled in Post-Secondary

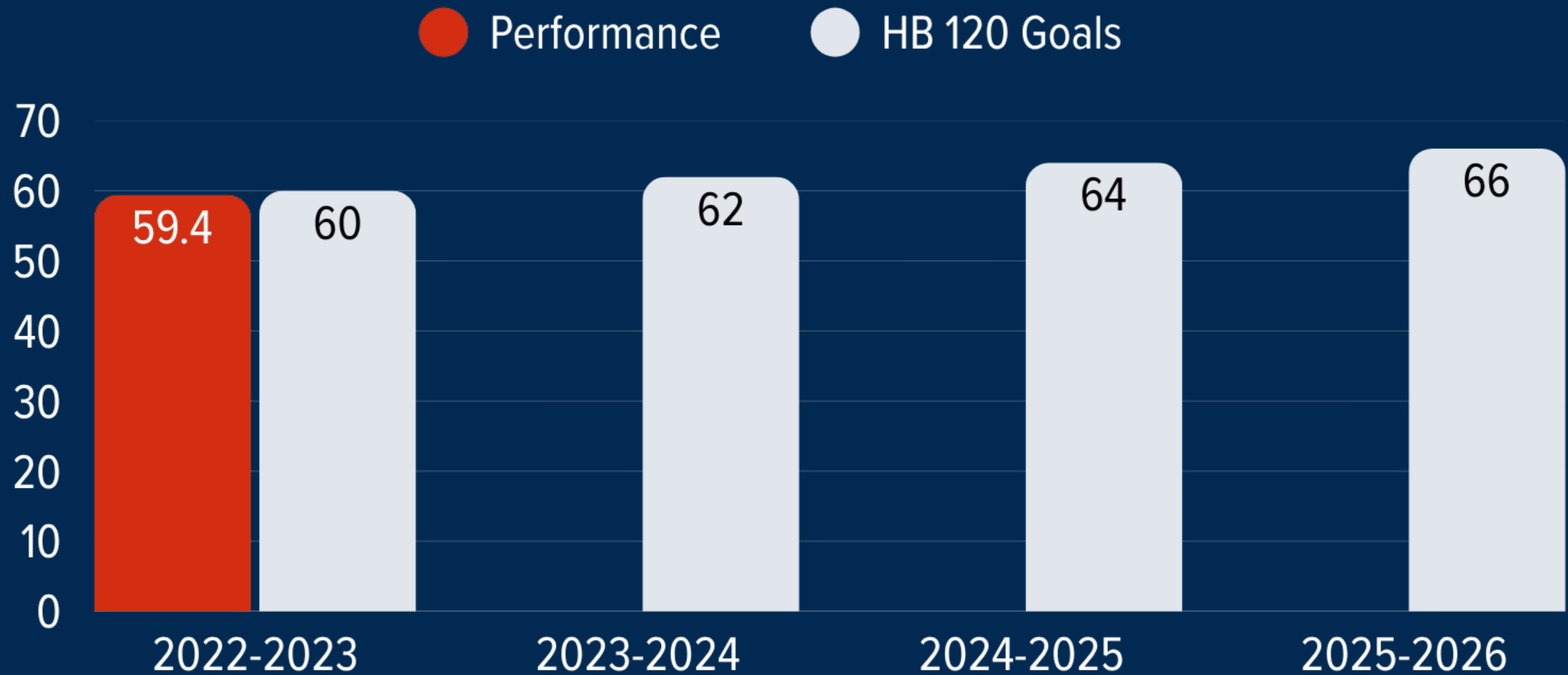
