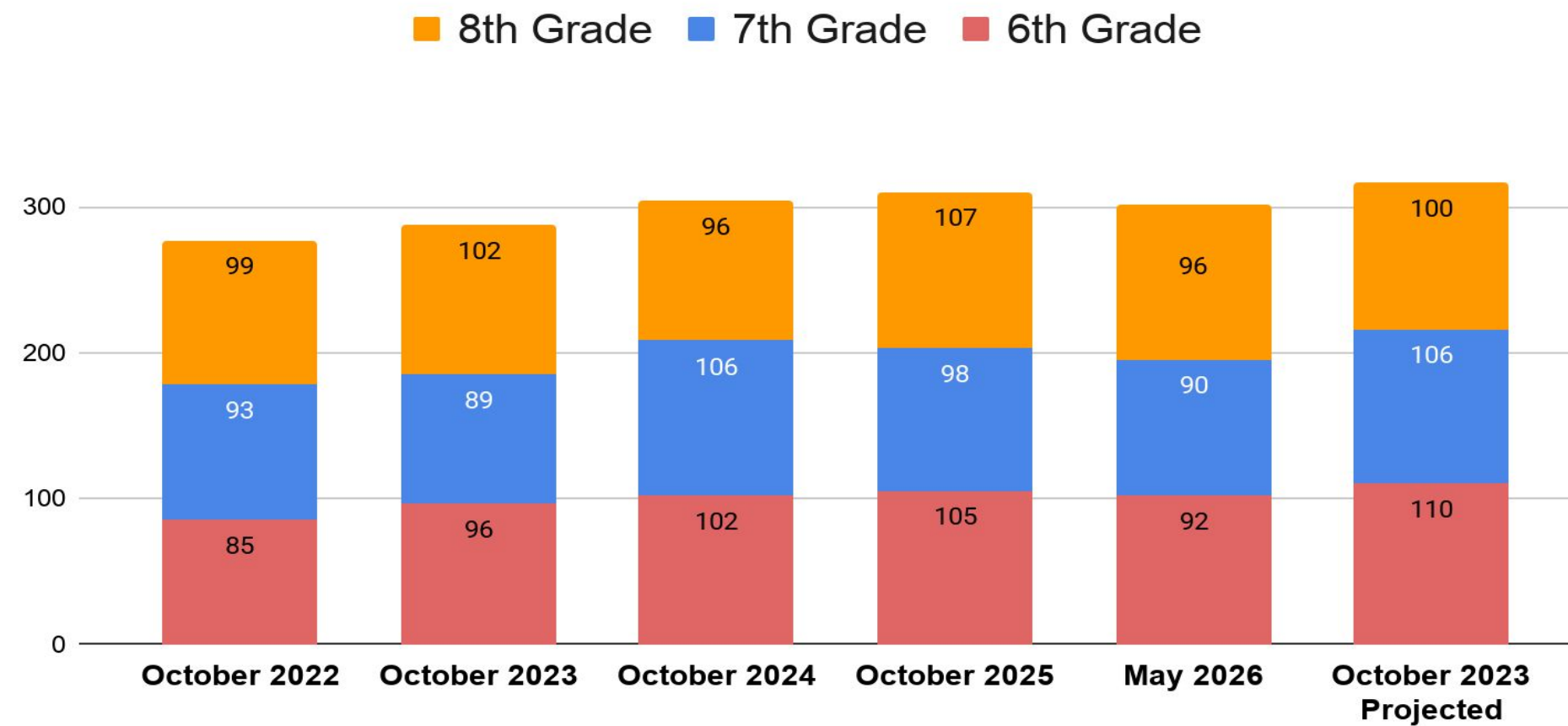

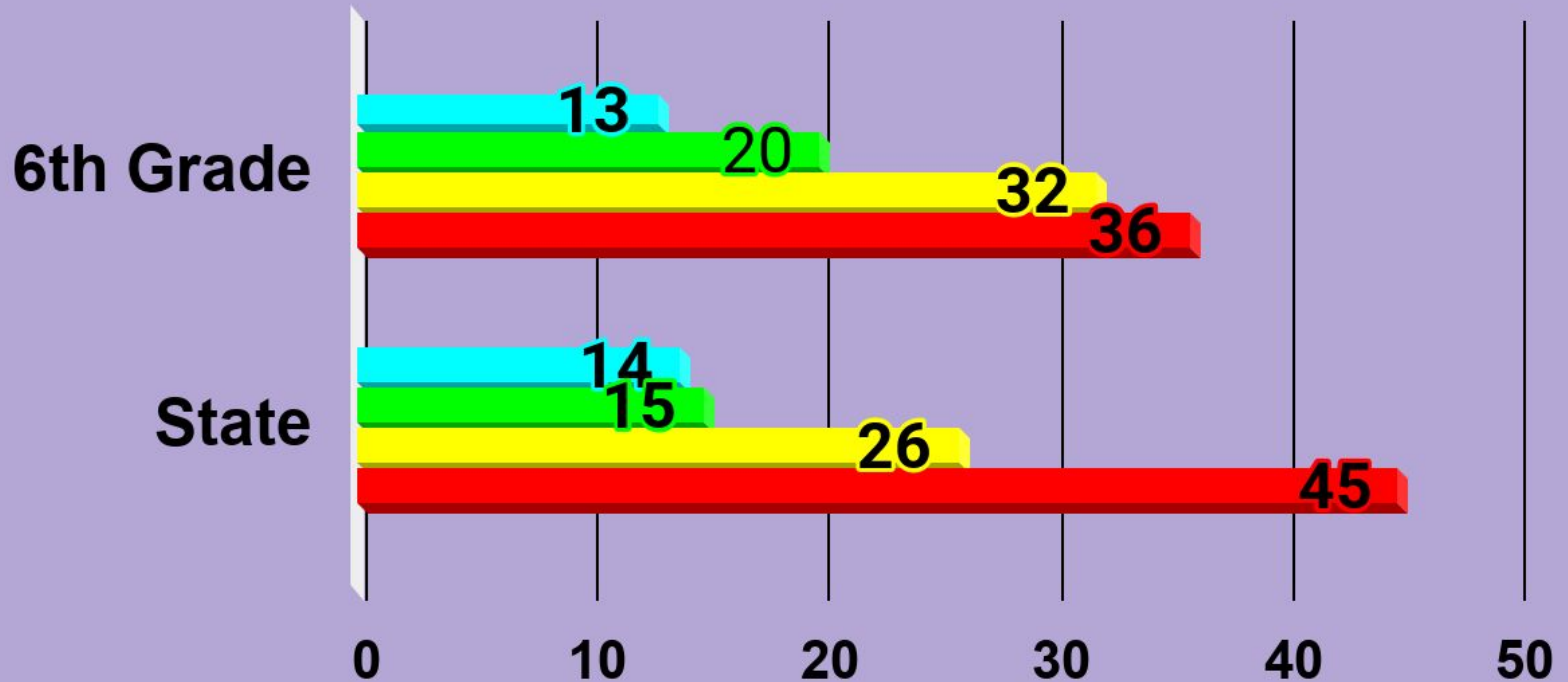

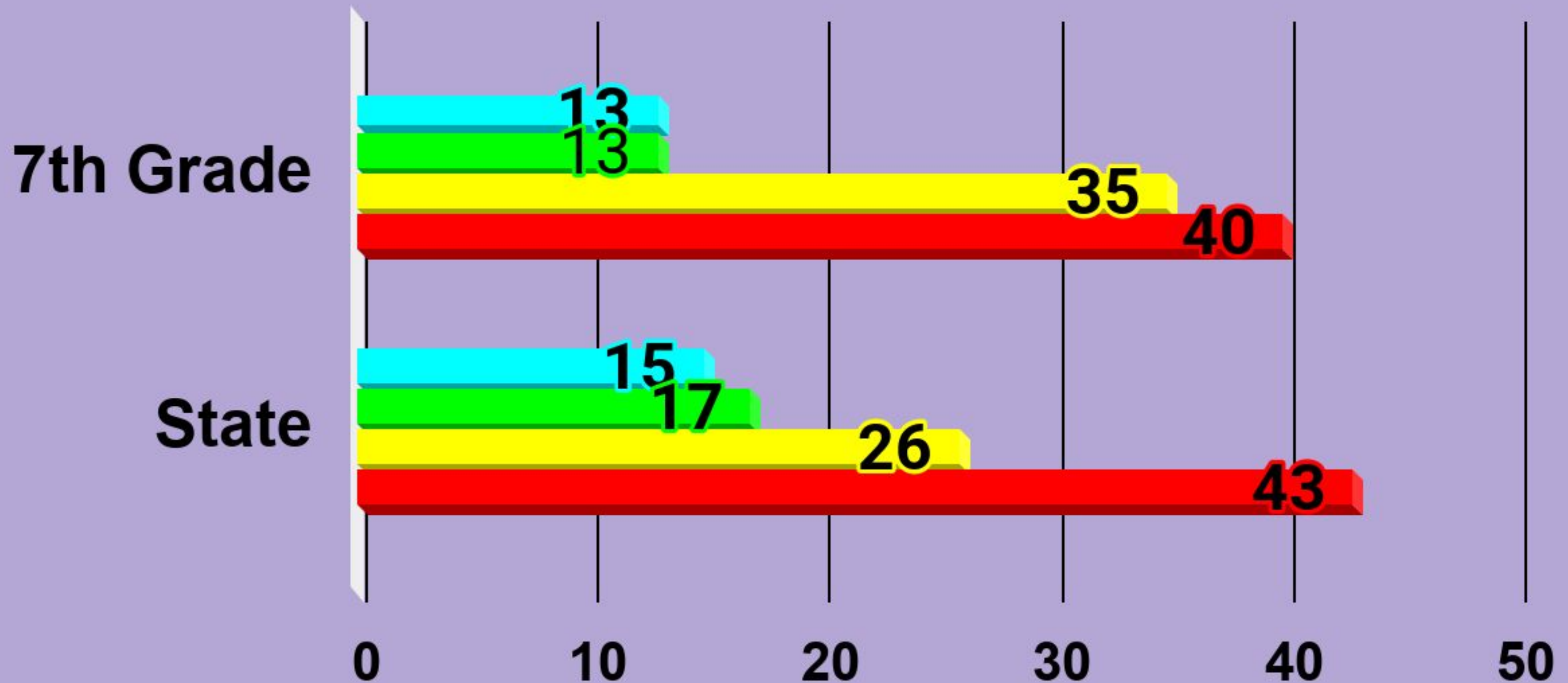

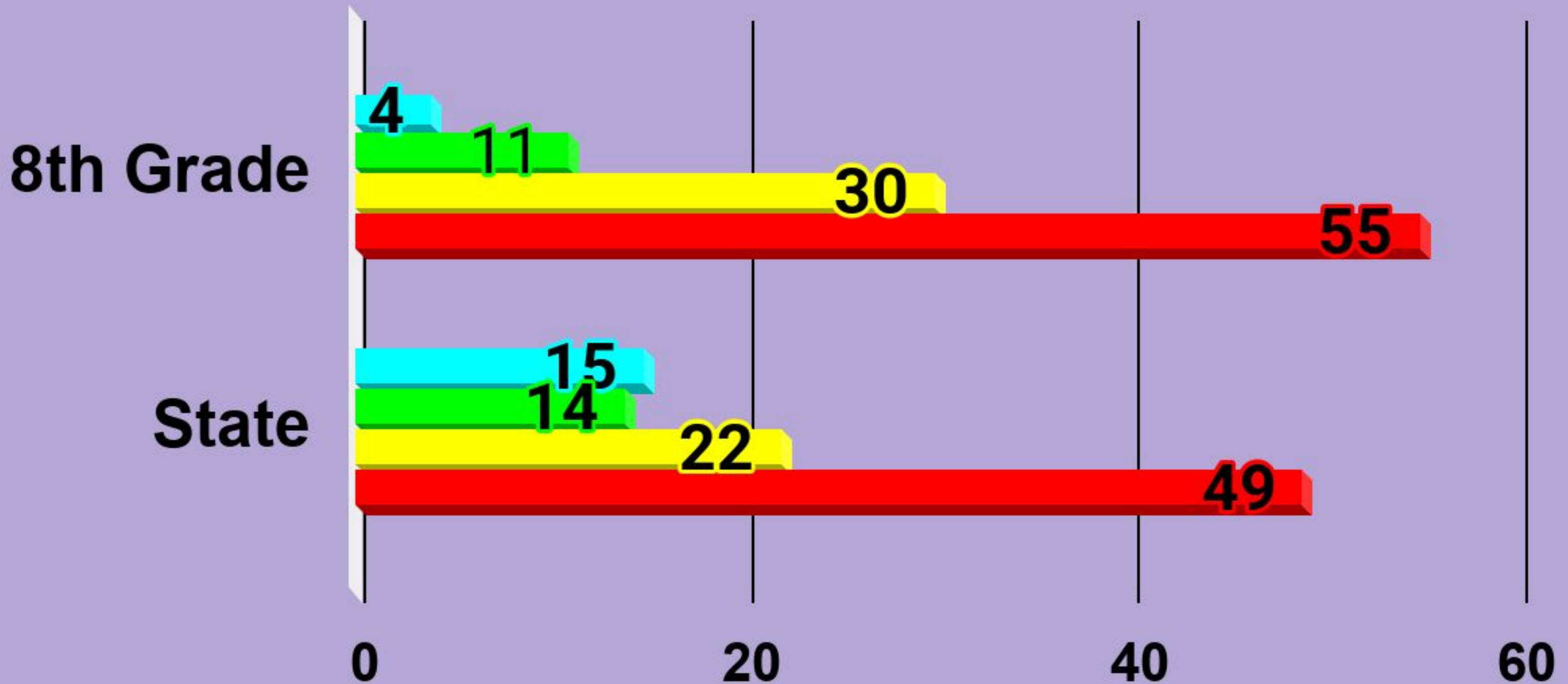

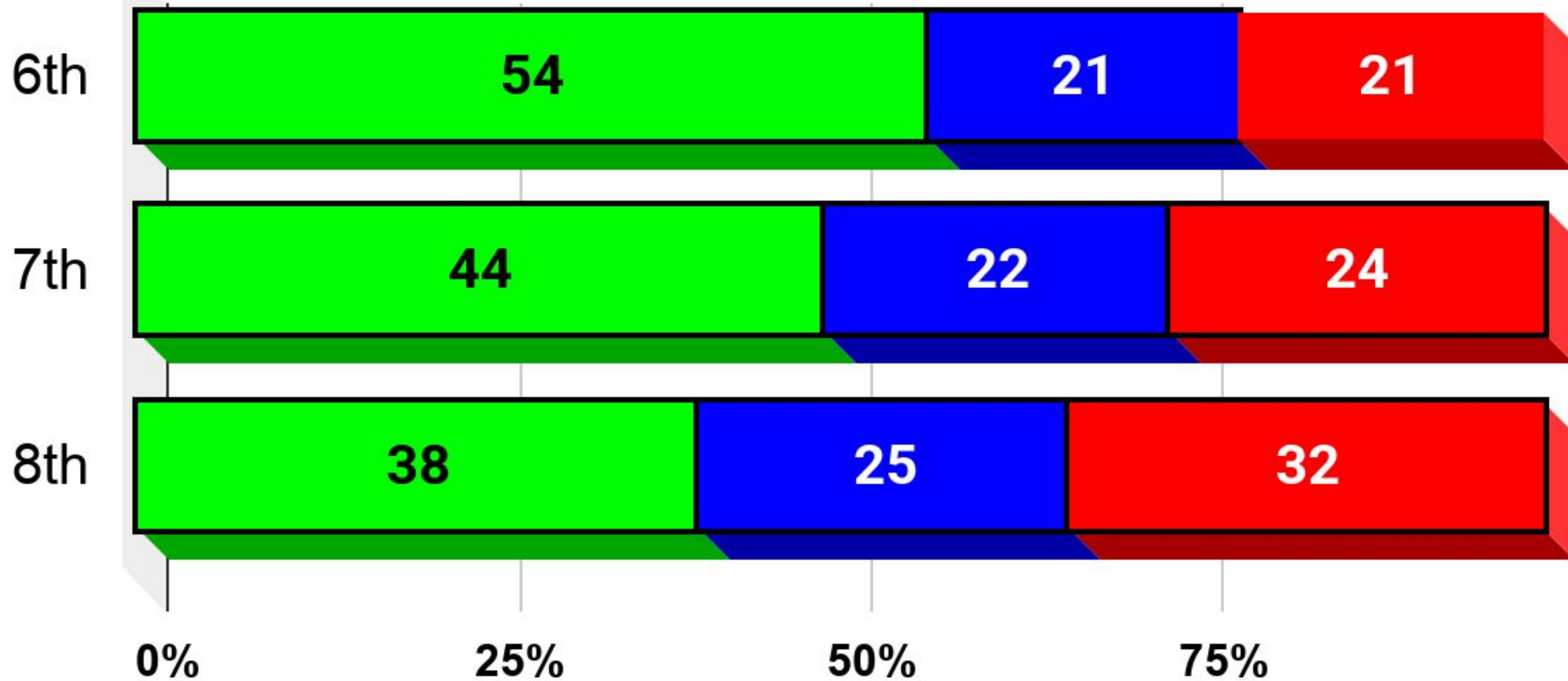

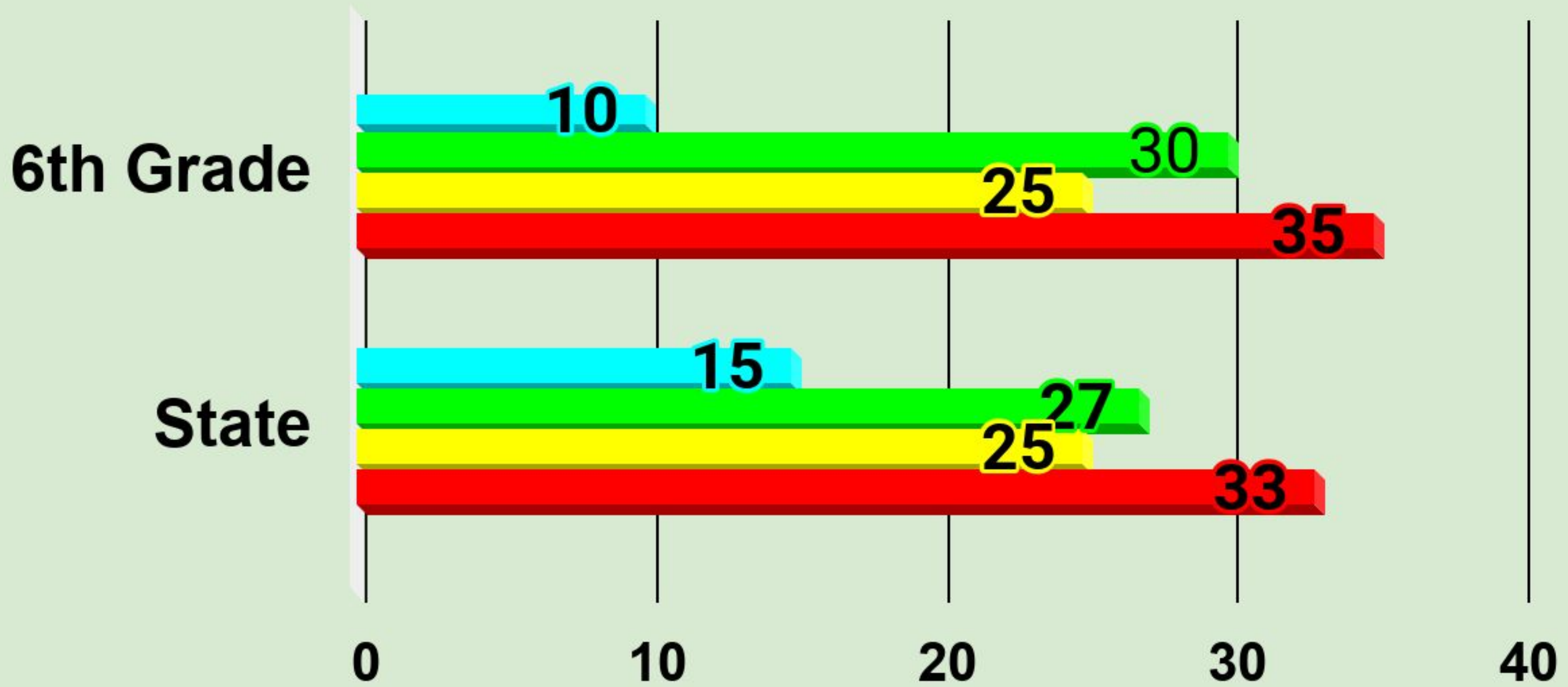
STAR MATH Winter Screening

■ # Of Students At or Above ■ # Close to Benchmark ■ # Low



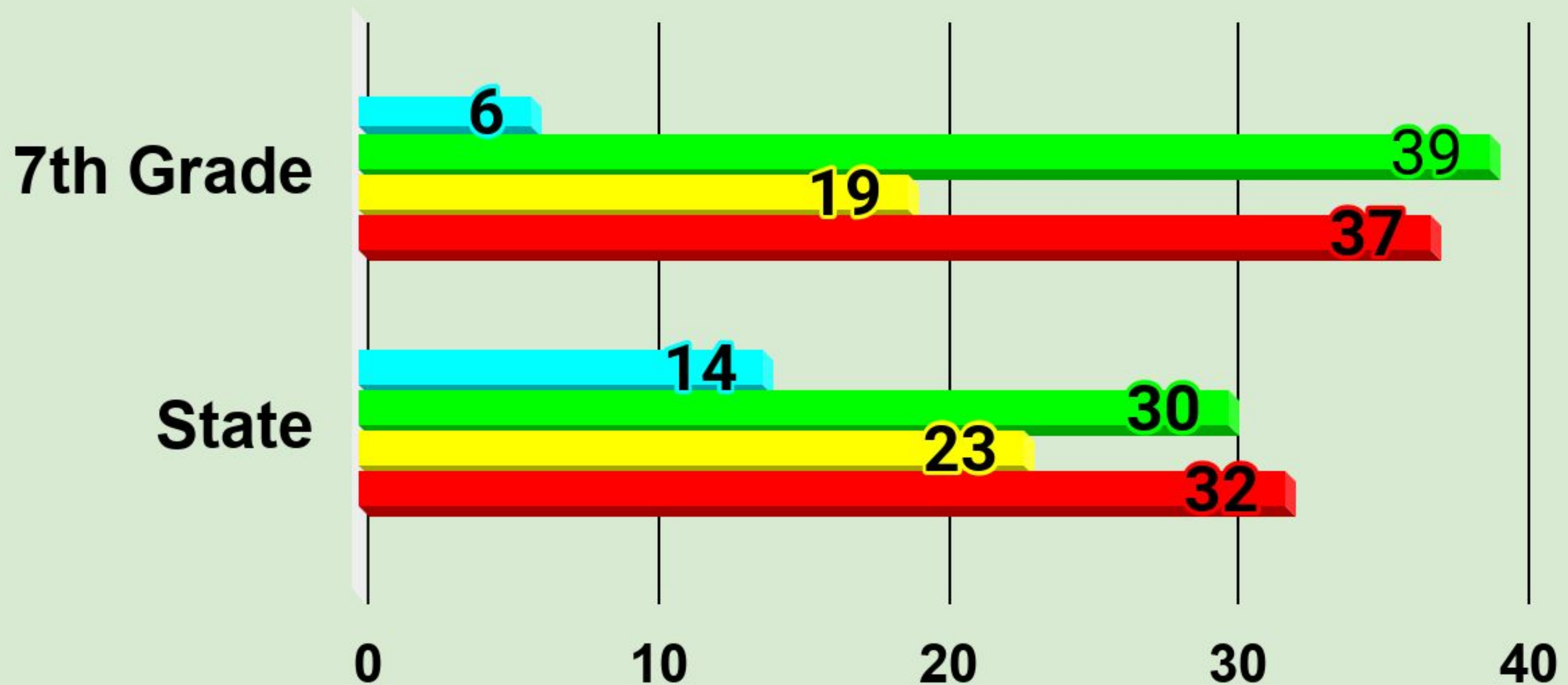

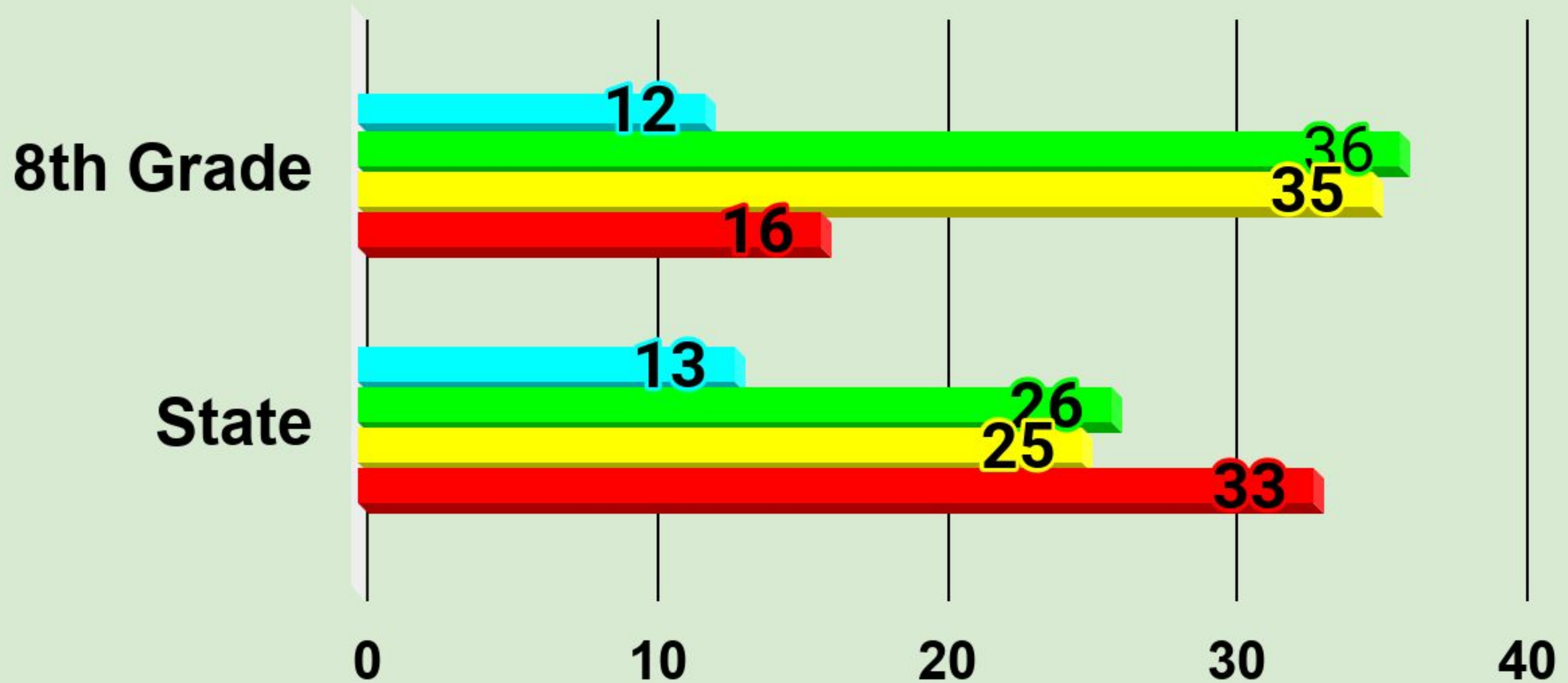

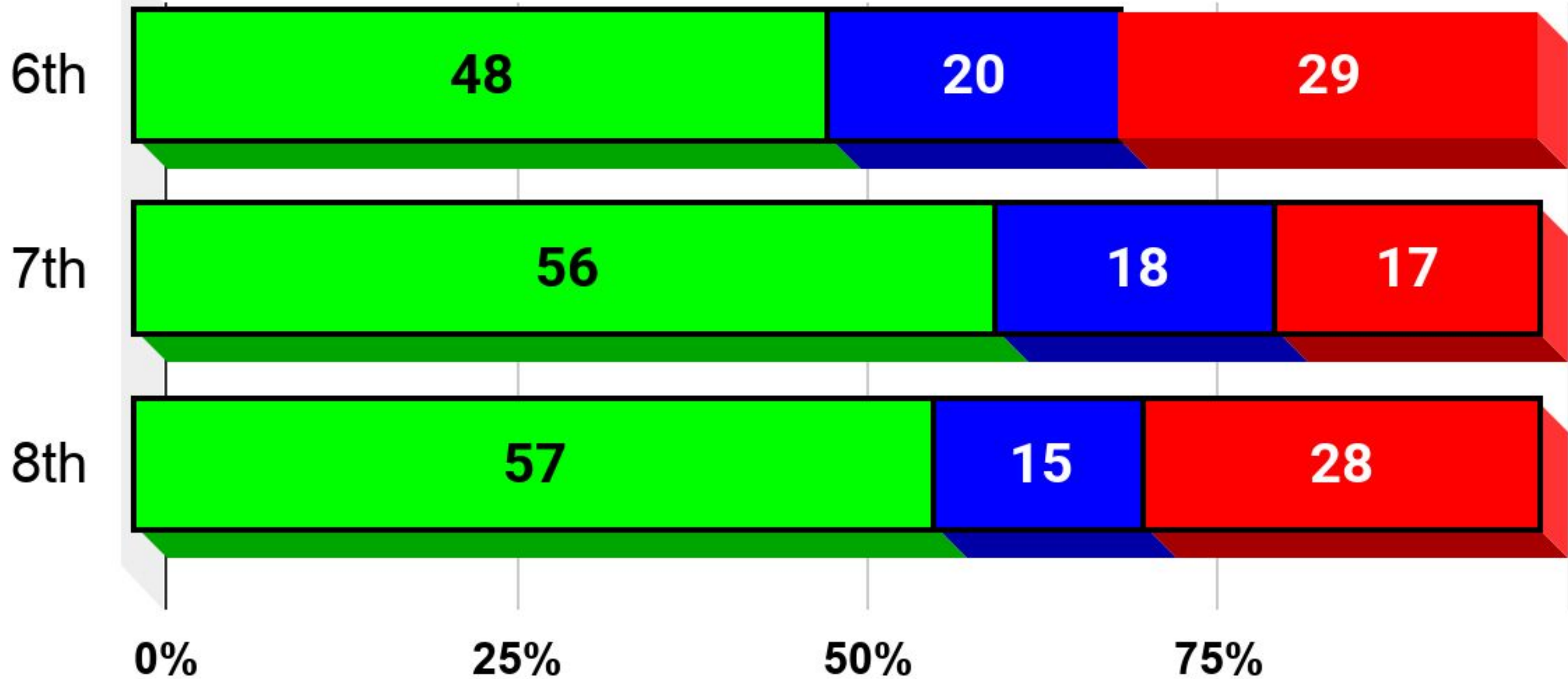

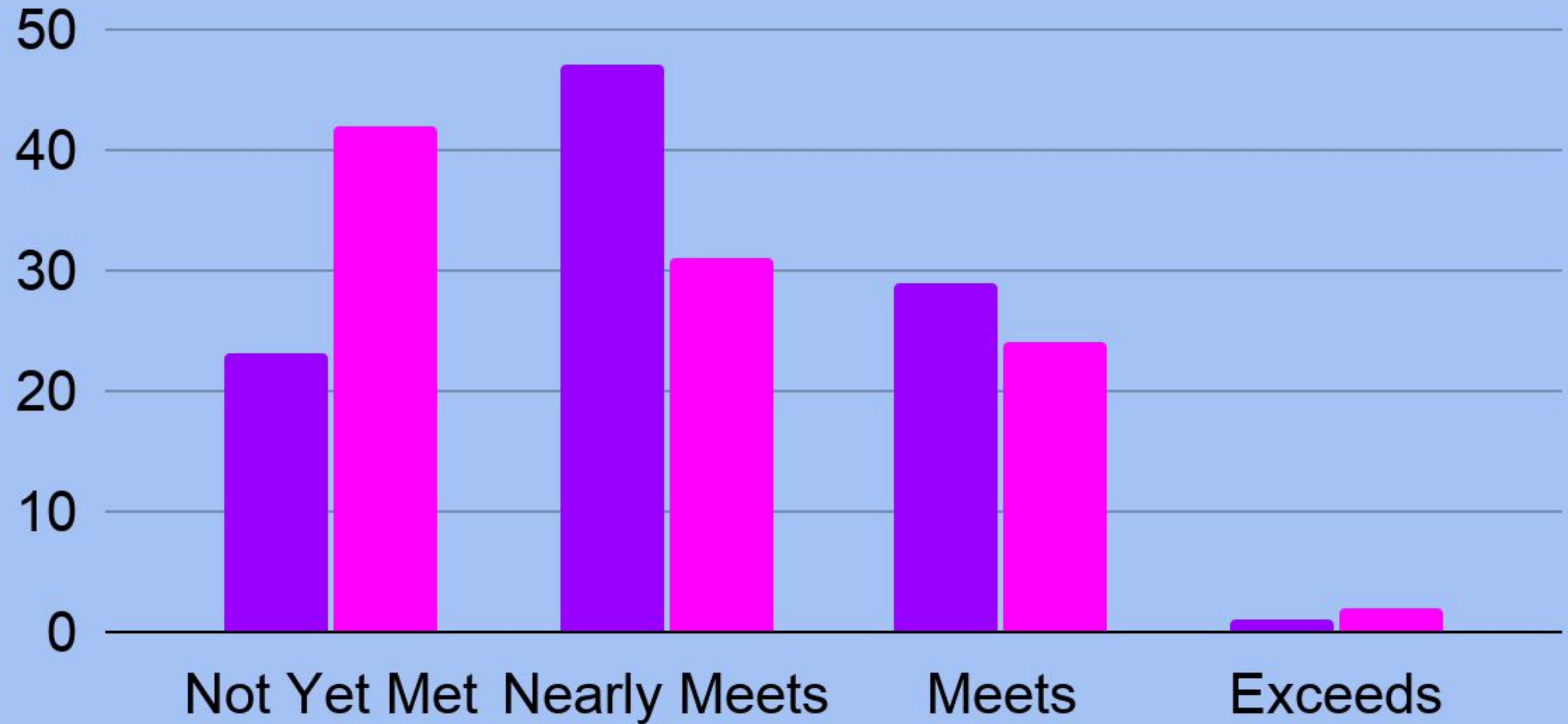
STAR Reading Winter Screening

■ # Of Students At or Above ■ # Close to Benchmark ■ # Low



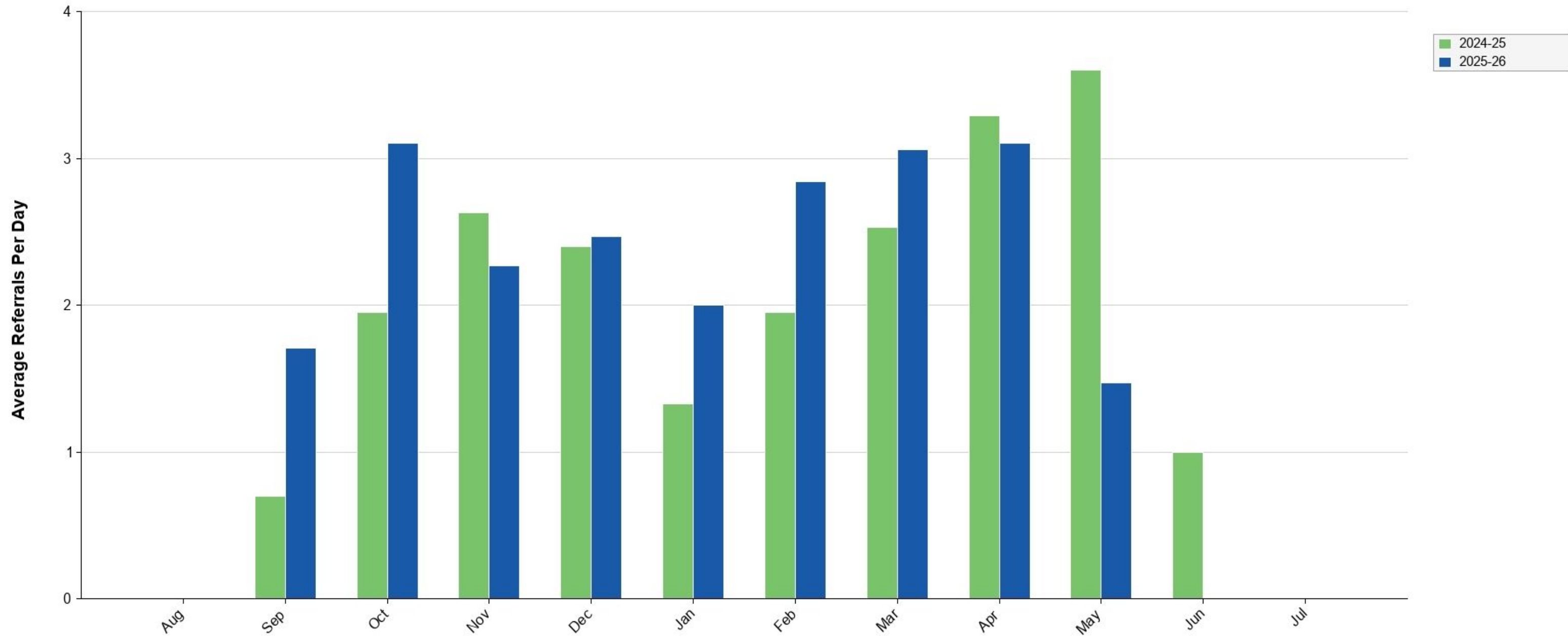
State Testing: 8th Grade Science 2024-25

Average Referrals Per Day Per Month - Multi-Year

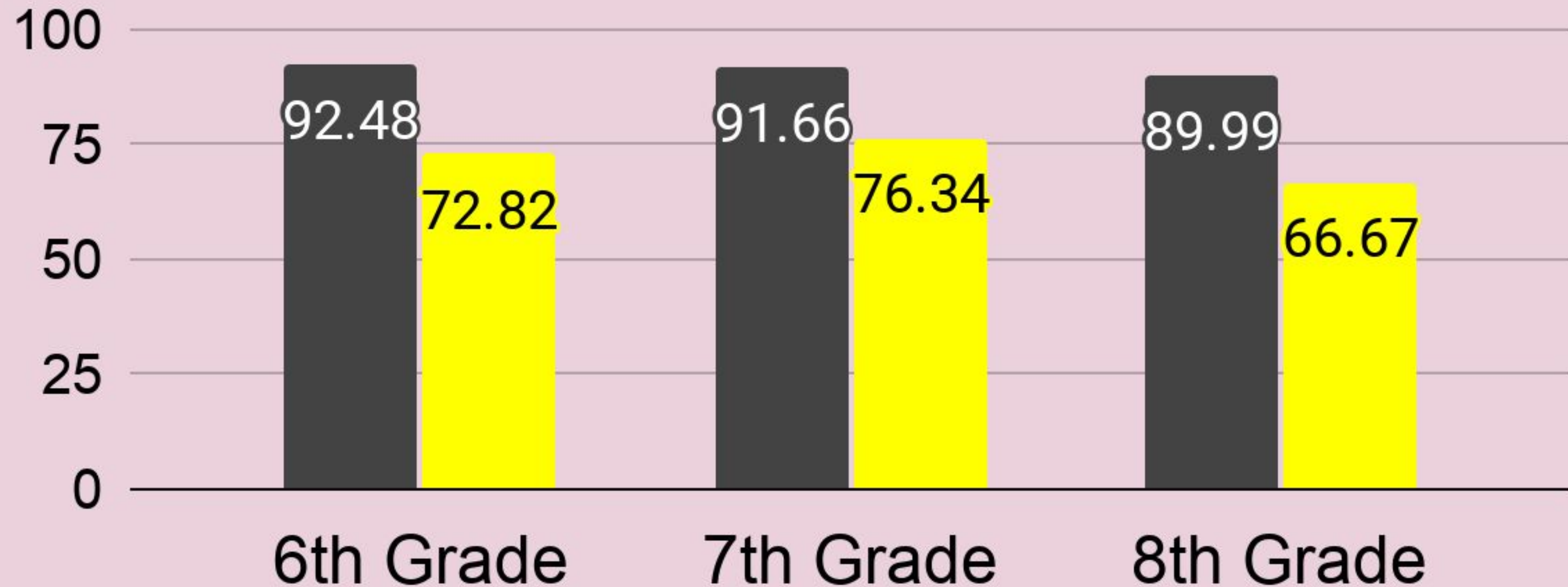

 - Determine which students need Tier 2 or Tier 3 Supports

- * Challenge Classes Provide Opportunities for Targeted Support and Enrichment

- *Utilizing WREN, FRMS Teacher Leaders received training this year on facilitating Data Team Meetings, facilitating Grade Level Meetings, and identifying strategies to support students academically, socially, and behaviorally.

- *FRMS Admin are also participating with WREN and other Admin staff to create district wide MTSS practices
