HISTORY:

The San Elizario Independent School District (SEISD) continues to support future educators and education-related careers through providing opportunities for students to intern and gain field experience in collaboration with exemplary SEISD employees to complete respective degrees and programs.

RATIONALE:

SEISD will serve as the practicum placement agency for a Brescia University student during the 2026–2027 academic year to support the completion of required practicum hours. Through this partnership, the San Elizario ISD continues its commitment to fostering the development of future professionals in educational support services.

The practicum experience outlined in this agreement is in the field of Speech-Language Pathology (SLP) and will provide the student with opportunities to gain practical experience in a school-based setting. These experiences will include exposure to larger caseload management, group therapy sessions, student evaluations, direct therapy services, and the development of competencies and professional skills expected of a Speech-Language Pathology practicum placement within a public-school environment.

BUDGET IMPACT:

This is a nonpaid internship. There is no SEISD budget impact.

ADMINISTRATIVE RECOMMENDATION:

The administrative recommendation is that the Board of Trustees approve the agreement for the SEISD to serve as the agency to allow an intern to work with the SEISD SLP in the Special Education Department.
