Violation of Cell Phone Policy

■ Elementary Schools

Cell phones are turned off and put away during the day.

- 1st Offense - Warning
- 2nd Offense - Teacher keeps until the end of the day and returns to the student.
- 3rd Offense - Principal keeps until the end of the day and returns to the student.
- 4th Offense- Principal keeps until the end of the day and returns to the parent.
- 5th Offense- Administrative Discretion





Middle Schools

- 1st Offense - Detention
- 2nd Offense - Confiscation of phone for 1 day
- 3rd Offense - Confiscation of phone for 2 days
- 4th Offense - Confiscation of phone for 3 days
- 5th Offense - Administrative Discretion

High Schools

- 1st Offense - Warning
- 2nd Offense - 1 Day of In-School Suspension
- 3rd Offense - 2 Days of In-School Suspension
- 4th Offense - Insubordination
 - = 1 Day Out of School Suspension
 - 5th Offense - Administrative Discretion
