Background Information

This agreement is required under Texas Government Code Section 772.013 (enacted by House Bill 33, 89th Legislative Session), which mandates that DPS and local governmental entities employing first responders enter into a coordinated framework for responding to and investigating active attack incidents at primary and secondary school facilities. The agreement establishes shared duties among the parties, commits participants to biennial multiagency tabletop exercises and in-person drills, and sets the stage for a follow-on working protocols agreement addressing communications interoperability, evidence collection coordination, and jurisdictional boundaries.

Recommendation

The Board is asked to ratify the district's participation in the Mutual Aid Agreement for Complex Emergency Response and Investigation Planning, executed among the Texas Department of Public Safety, the Dallas County Sheriff's Office, and area first responder agencies, including school district police departments, municipal police departments, and school districts within Dallas County.
