<p><b>Kyle Luedtke</b> Superintendent</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● On Monday, Feb. 9 I attended a WASBO workshop on Declining Enrollment at CESA 11. Sharing staff, whole grade sharing and consolidation were discussed. Currently the State Assembly has six bills on the floor addressing consolidation or whole grade sharing.</li> <li>● Libby Cheever and I attended a seminar on self-funded health insurance provided by Alera Group. We then had a follow up meeting with Alera. At this time we are going to continue with SF Insurance Group as our broker. I am meeting with SF on Feb. 24 to discuss health insurance for 2026-27. Although we are only moving 2 teachers into different grade levels, 7 teachers will be engaged in learning new content areas this spring with support from our instructional coach and identified teacher leaders. Our teams are feeling very positive about the opportunity to be able to plan and prepare this early.</li> <li>● 3rd-8th grade teams, including 10th grade Social Studies, utilized the January and February Inservices to engage in some early preparation for our upcoming state assessments. We want to make sure we continue providing all the proactive efforts that clearly impacted student performance the last couple years. Growth is the goal for all students.</li> <li>● The elementary thematic unit has kicked off with the 2026 Winter Olympics opening ceremonies on February 6th! Thanks to Youth Sports Unlimited, KG-5th grade students enjoyed a day at Trollhaugen, snow tubing in the very timely beautiful temperatures! We determined that next steps with CESA are pulling apart our state test scores and relooking at our essential standards, and how they align the state report card.</li> <li>● I sat down with CESA to talk about our current state of Gifted and Talented</li> </ul>

programming, and had feedback as to how they can support our district to make this process more equitable and consistent. This conversation is ongoing with the admin team, and we are working at making a better process that will benefit the students of the district.
