

SUBJECT:	Consideration and possible approval of the adoption of Prevailing Wage Rates reflected in Exhibit 'A' for use on all PISD Facilities projects.
BACKGROUND:	The Texas Government Code Chapter 2258 requires school districts, including PISD, to adopt Prevailing Wage Rates setting the minimum hourly wages to be paid to construction workers engaged in public works projects in PISD. PBK Architects, Inc., on behalf of public school districts in the Texas Gulf Coast area, conducts a survey every three years of Prevailing Wage Rates for construction trades in accordance with the requirements of Texas Government Code Chapter 2258, and is recommended for adoption. PISD also includes the following language into District standard job specifications issued for all PISD projects: "Pasadena ISD supports high standards and job placement for its students, graduates, and community trades, and therefore encourages contractors to create high quality workforce opportunities through programs such as the US Department of Labor registered Apprenticeship Programs."
