Description:

MOU with Common Threads (CT). CT was created to bring health and wellness to children, families and communities through cooking and nutrition education. By integrating preventative health programs into school districts and community organizations, CT not only helps combat the rising number of diet-related diseases, but also cultivates a culture that embraces a healthier lifestyle and celebrates diversity through food. CT provides student programming and staff professional development as well as family programming too. All of this is provided for free thanks to grant funding CT receives from the Texas Health & Human Services' SNAP Department.
