Background Information

The Texas Education Agency (TEA) released STAAR results for High School students in late May and early June for 3rd - 8th grade students. We are still waiting for the 5th and 8th grade science results to be released. The TEKS were revised in these grade areas, which impacted the content on the assessments. To ensure that the updated content on the assessment does not increase or decrease the difficulty of the tests, standard-setting processes are still being conducted, and the final results will be released on July 31, 2026, for all students.

District and campus administrators, along with teachers and professional staff, are currently disaggregating data this summer to create plans for teacher professional learning and for instruction that support individual student needs on our campuses. This data is shaping the development of our district and campus improvement plans. We have many celebrations this year, but also areas of growth. In the 2026-2027 school year, we continue to target middle grades math and social studies as areas of focus. We will also continue to focus on elementary math growth on all campuses.

The slides present a four-year view, which aligns with the STAAR 2.0 test administration. Data is disaggregated by subject, grade, and performance band. Midway continues to perform above the state and region in all subjects. We saw modest gains in most areas, but are excited to see gains in the Masters area of performance in many subjects this year.
