

D2 Technology Department Board Report - June 2026

Spring assessments were completed successfully, and the 2025–2026 school year concluded smoothly from a technology services perspective. As teachers and students begin a well-earned summer break, the Technology Services Department is shifting fully into summer preparation for the 2026–2027 school year.

Student registration for the 2026–2027 school year opened in April. Families are encouraged to complete registration early so that student records, scheduling, transportation, staffing, and related systems can be prepared as efficiently as possible.

The Technology Services Department is preparing for annual year-end ISBE data submissions and the summer student information system rollover, which resets student records, schedules, settings, and related data for the upcoming school year.

A significant portion of the department's summer work is focused on device preparation and the District's continued return to a structured technology replacement cycle. New Chromebooks have been ordered, and Chromebooks throughout the District are being enrolled, reset, updated, cleaned, and repaired. Student iPads are also being reset and updated.

The District also continues to replace staff devices and classroom technology according to the established replacement plan. New laptops are being ordered, and existing staff laptops are being reimaged in preparation for the new school year.

Summer infrastructure work is underway, including strengthening wireless security, updating firmware and software across district network systems, and installing new Ethernet cabling to support room changes. The department is also continuing to await USAC funding approval for planned battery backup units.
