Homebound Instruction

~~Home or hospital instruction will be provided for any student of school age who is unable to attend school because of a physical disability and can profit from the service.~~

~~The student must, however, have a signed statement from the examining physician that qualifies that student under one of the following provisions:~~

~~1.——Certified cases (partially reimbursed by the Oregon Department of Education:~~

- ~~a.——A disabling or chronically ill condition that is permanent;~~
- ~~b.——A disabling or chronically ill condition that has continued for a period of 10 consecutive school days.~~

~~2.——Noncertified cases (district supported):~~

- ~~a.——A physical disability or an illness that has extended continuously for a period of 10 school days.~~

~~Homebound instruction will not normally be furnished for those students excluded from school because of behavior problems.~~

Instruction will be provided to any student whose health or impairment will, as substantiated by a physician's statement, cause the student to be absent from school for at least 10 consecutive school days and who can benefit educationally from such instruction.

The amount of instructional service provided will be related to each student's educational needs and physical and mental health.
