Describe the type of work applicant wishes to perform on City right-of-way:

Unite Private Networks (UPN) is requesting permission to construct facilities occupying the

ROW of the City of Bennet Public Roads to place underground bored 2" HDPE conduit with

fiber cable along the North side of Apple Street (starting at an existing box by Jefferson Street)

to the East side of Monroe Street/NE-43, and North to First Nebraska Bank, 50 Monroe St

All detailed information such as locations, elevations, cuts, fills, distances, and dimensions shall be shown on applicant's plans and specifications as submitted to the City of Bennet.

GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS

Construction shall comply with the current edition of the State of Nebraska Department of Roads Standard Specifications for Highway Construction.

No open cuts of any kind, including boring, on hard surfaced roads will be allowed, except by express written permission from the City of Bennet.

Backfill of open trenches shall be placed in lifts not exceeding eight (8) inches uncompacted thickness and each layer mechanically compacted at optimum moisture content (18%) to a density at least 95% or equal to that of the existing undisturbed ground which will prevent excessive settlement or shrinkage. Compaction tests shall be required with test results given to the City of Bennet for their records. Photos shall also be submitted showing before, during and after construction.

No backfilling shall take place in freezing weather except with the permission of the City of Bennet. No backfill shall be made with frozen materials.

All disturbed areas shall be left in a condition as near to original as possible (grading, rock replacement, seeding or sod). All applicants shall be required to maintain said area for a six (6) month period following the completion of work. At any time within the six (6) month time period the contractor will be notified by the City of Bennet if any re-compaction in the construction area or road material (i.e. rock, gravel, etc.) is to be repaired or replaced.

Trenching across gravel roads will not be permitted without the approval of the City of Bennet and only provided it is accomplished in increments of one-half of the roadway at a time. At least one-half of the traveled width of the roadway shall be kept open and free of obstruction at all times.

The applicant is responsible for all barricading. The barricades shall conform to the barricading standards, specification, methods and materials as per the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices.

The closing of a road will not be permitted without approval of the City of Bennet.

The applicant shall provide the City of Bennet with a certificate of insurance naming the City of Bennet as an additional insured.

Any exceptions to the criteria outlined above must be reviewed and approved by the City of Bennet.

I (We) agree to perform the work in accordance with the permit and attached drawings and to maintain the area of construction for a period of six (6) months as set forth in the above permit. This permit may be canceled at any time by the applicant prior to construction of the work.
