Updates:

- End of the year MTSS academic and behavioral meetings were held to allow for effective transition to the next grade level.
- Transitional meetings and observations were completed for all students with special education services, major behavior, and academic concerns.
- The intervention schedule was revamped so that interventions no longer have to occur during special classes such as art, music, pe, library, STEM, and science. Each grade level will have an intervention block for both reading and math, allowing interventionists to flood a grade level, group students appropriately and differentiate their instruction. Grade level teachers will be able to differentiate for those students who remain in their classrooms, thus allowing for enrichment and more individualized/small group instruction.
- All teachers received a copy of the Master Schedule and Grade level schedules before leaving, thus eliminating the anxious anticipation of those documents in August. For those who like to plan ahead, this information is very useful.
- Feedback was sought from grade level teams, individual teachers, and support staff regarding professional development needs for the 2026-2027 year to assist in planning.
- First grade assessment binders were finalized for ELA and Math.

- Teachers and staff were celebrated thoroughly during the month of May during teacher appreciation week. They received many meals: a lunch provided and served by district personnel, a breakfast from RCES PTO, and a lunch provided by RCES administrators. In addition, the RCES admin provided a drink bar on Monday, a mint treat on Tuesday, a bookmark on Wednesday, and a large customized tote bag on Thursday.
- End of the year celebrations and activities were held including pizza parties for library workers and student leaders, student recognitions for Lion's Club, the rewarding of a new bike to the third grader showing the most growth in reading, special education pizza making party, end of the year programs, and a retirement celebration for Mrs. Hahn. All students enjoyed the end of the year programs and annual bounce house, reward day. The Battle of the Books and the annual Reading Rally were also conducted.
