



Memorandum of Understanding

This memorandum of understanding is between the **Coastal Bend Wellness Foundation – Youth Programs Department** and **Calallen Independent School District** in **Nueces County**. The purpose of this agreement is to establish a collaboration to implement prevention programs, to address health and wellness in youth and adults by enhancing protective factors that increase knowledge, skills, and attitudes toward making healthy choices. Youth Programs is funded by the Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC) and is offered at **no charge** to participating schools and organizations.

Fiscal Year of Service: FY 26 (9/1/26 to 8/31/27) and FY 27 (9/1/27 to 8/31/28)

- Services will be: Curriculum **and/or** Presentations **and/or** Positive Alternatives
- Day/s and time: **Mondays at 2:00pm (every week, rotating the curriculum)**
- Notes: Middle School Students only

Youth Programs will provide:

- Trained Specialists to teach and implement an evidence-based curriculum/prevention strategy
- Trained Specialists to deliver alcohol, tobacco, and other drugs (ATOD) presentations.
- Curriculum and presentation materials/supplies
- Pre/post surveys for those applicable
- Presentations to teachers, counselors, and parents involved with agreed parties
- Alternative Activities, if requested
- Conduct prevention services and implement strategies that target the identified primary and secondary populations as appropriate

Calallen ISD's Discipline Alternative Education Program (DAEP) will provide:

- Adequate classroom/presentation space for service delivery
- A contact person to assist with scheduling and programming at each site
- Minimum of 30 minutes for activities
- Required time for evidence-based curriculum
- Completion of pre/post surveys for those applicable
- Participate in data collection and evaluation activities as needed/required, ie. participant demographics
- Notification of all school events/health fairs appropriate for Youth Programs to attend
- An additional day to conduct pre/post-survey for evidence-based curriculum, as required by HHSC
- School personnel (teacher, teacher's aide, coach, etc.) in the classroom while Specialists are delivering services
