Background Information

The School District annually procures products and services from multiple vendors with aggregate expenditures of \$50,000 or more to support the ongoing operation of district facilities and instructional programs. These purchases are critical to maintaining uninterrupted educational services and ensuring students and staff have access to the resources necessary for a successful school year.

These purchases are typically initiated prior to the start of each school year to ensure all resources, equipment, subscriptions, and service agreements are in place before students return to campus. Establishing these contracts and securing required materials in advance helps prevent disruptions to instruction, facility operations, student services, and food service programs.

There is a listing attached of 45 vendors that include transportation, instructional materials, nutrition, maintenance and teaching and learning.

Recommendation

The District recommends that the Board of Trustees approve all yearly contracts that will cost at or above the \$50,000 threshold over the course of the school year or in yearly aggregate. These contracts are in place to maintain the integrity of the District and the continue the programs needed to sustain the success of the students and staff within the District.
