REGULAR BOARD MEETING MINUTES

June 16, 2026

9:00 A.M. NPT Office

CALL REGULAR BOARD MEETING TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL at 9:00 am

Dr. Scott Doerr called the meeting to order and roll call was taken with all board members present. In attendance were Dr. Scott Doerr, Mr. Kevin McDonald as proxy for Mrs. Jessica Miller and Mrs. Brandi Bruley. Also present was NPT Director, Kelly Suey and Business Manager, Dee Tarter.

Others in attendance: NPT Payroll Clerk/Admin Assistant, Joni Fleigle, Lori Wemple, and Luke Wemple.

RECOGNITION OF VISITORS, PUBLIC COMMENT, AND CORRESPONDENCE

There were none.

MOVE TO APPROVE THE June 16, 2026 CONSENT AGENDA AS PRESENTED.

Financial reports were presented and second reading of the new Board Policies.

Motion by Bruley, seconded by McDonald to approve the June 16, 2026 consent agenda as presented. Bruley - YEA, Doerr - YEA, McDonald - YEA. Motion passes 3-0.

The consent agenda included Minutes from the Regular Executive Board meeting from May 19, 2026, 2nd reading of the new Board Policies, and Bills/Treasurer's Report.

OLD BUSINESS

Review and Approve Lease for TLC Daycare for early access (June 1) and purchase of contents of building

NPT had verbally agreed with the TLC Building Committee that we would be allowed early access to the building in order to get things moved, painted, internet set up, etc. at a discounted rate of \$500.00. In addition, NPT agreed to purchase the remaining items in the building for a flat fee of \$1000.00. The attached lease or agreement includes this information.

Motion by Bruley, seconded by McDonald to approve the supplemental agreement to lease the building in June and the purchase of the contents of the building as presented. Bruley - YEA, Doerr - YEA McDonald - YEA. Motion passes 3-0.

NEW BUSINESS

Review and Approve Property/Casualty/Liability Insurance Renewals

Mrs. Suey reviewed the attached property/casualty/liability insurance renewal, It does not include the new building yet due to us trying to get some required information from TLC to provide to our insurance carrier. The current increase in rate is 7.04% (or \$2,178.79). This will be amended once we are able to provide the insurance carrier with the needed information.

Motion by McDonald, seconded by Bruley to approve the Property/Casualty/Liability Insurance Renewals as presented. Bruley - YEA, Doerr -YEA McDonald - YEA. Motion passes 3-0.

Discuss and appoint FY27 board officer positions

The board decided to keep the board officer positions as they are.

Motion by Bruley, seconded by McDonald to approve Dr. Doerr as the Chair/President, Mrs. Miller as the Co-Chair/VP, and Mrs. Bruley as the secretary for the 2026-2027 year. tMotion passes by voice vote 3-0.

Review and approve FY27 Preliminary Budget for billing purposes effective July 1, 2026

Mrs. Suey reviewed the preliminary budget. This is for billing purposes so that NPT can start billing member districts on July 1, 2026. Mrs. Tarter will review specific numbers at our next board meeting on July 2, 2026 at 2pm at the next board meeting

Motion by Bruley, seconded by McDonald to approve the FY27 Preliminary Budget for billing purposes effective July 1, 2026 as presented. Bruley - YEA, Doerr -YEA McDonald - YEA. Motion passes 3-0.

Mrs. Suey discussed hiring Trista Wiseman and Ashley Loy as paraprofessionals for the new building. She discussed maternity leave requests for Karmyn Pavolka and Ashley Yockey. Carli Hanlon will be the Behavior Interventionist for Taylorville North and Jr High. There is also a resignation for Kimberly Franklin who was a paraprofessional.

Motion by McDonald seconded by Bruley, to approve the personnel hiring, maternity leave requests, and resignation as presented. Bruley - YEA, Doerr -YEA McDonald - YEA. Motion passes 3-0.

After the vote was made, Dr Doerr wanted to discuss Karmyn Pavolka's request to work prior to the start of the school year. Mrs. Suey explained Karmyn was going to work a couple days early to set up schedules so she could see students sooner than when she normally would and bank minutes for the quarter since she was going on maternity leave. She explained this would also be cost saving to the district. Since she is a 180 day employee, the board members did not agree with the permission for working days prior to the start of the school year. .

Having voted on the affirmative, I move to reconsider the previous vote for Personnel. Motion by Doerr, seconded by McDonald to reconsider the Personnel vote. Bruley - YEA, Doerr -YEA McDonald - YEA. Motion passes 3-0.

Motion by Doerr, seconded by McDonald to approve Trista Wiseman and Ashley Loy as paraprofessionals, Maternity Leave request for Ashley Yockey, resignation of Kimberly Franklin, and hire of Carli Hanson as Behavior Interventionist. Bruley - YEA, Doerr -YEA McDonald - YEA. Motion passes 3-0.

Motion by Bruley, seconded by McDonald to approve Karmyn Pavolka's maternity leave minus the extra days worked. Bruley - YEA, Doerr -YEA McDonald - YEA. Motion passes 3-0.

Director's Report

The first session of ESY is complete and went very well. Thank-you to Sabrina Jones and Maggie Kuykendall for helping with the program and ensuring that everything was complete.

Mrs. Suey gave an update on the move to the new building. A ***Huge*** thank-you to Pana and Taylorville maintenance crews for helping NPT load and unload all of the things from the Pana NPT office. They couldn't have done it without them! They have most of their office and classroom items moved into the new building. CTI began working on the internet on June 11 and plan to finish this week. The floors are all buffed and waxed. The classrooms, hallways and all offices are getting painted. Food service is secured through Taylorville Schools. Mrs. Suey is currently working on an Intake Packet to send to parents to fill out, sign ups for meet the teacher, and letters to go home to parents that includes class supply list and sensory regulation information. She is also working with the local 4H coordinator to find ways to incorporate 4H into the new building. Maggie Kuykendall has also expressed interest in working on our Special Olympics team. They will be meeting soon to try and get that up and functional soon.

Causes of Revenue Increase

- Regular Assessment Increase by \$195,559.65 (\$2,157,020.42 to \$2,352,580.07)
 - This is due to raises for FY27, hiring 2 full time SLP, Hearing Itinerant & Vision Itinerant (which lowered purchased services) hiring a School Social Worker intern, Behavioral Interventionist, School Psychologist, a part time SLP to full time, covering 3 maternity leaves, estimating benefits, and utilities (internet, water, trash, electricity, security) being added.
- FACES Assessment increased by \$375,517.78 (\$1,220,027.50 to \$1,595,545.28)
 - This is due to raises for FY27, adding another class which includes hiring 2 paraprofessionals and 1 teacher. NPT hiring a teacher to replace a Taylorville retired teacher, nurse, janitor, mentor stipends, estimating benefits, technical support, increase in purchase service for fire alarm system cost, and increase in capital material for purchase of interactive display boards.

The teams also meet with the special education administration quarterly to review <i>IEPs: Guide to Writing Individualized Education Programs</i> that is being studied relating to IEP's. CPDU's are provided. NPT also provides mentoring to new special education teachers that are hired by the member districts, as requested. These mentoring opportunities can be individualized to the needs of the member districts, be it small groups or one-on-one.
