## Oregon Classic Financial

16 Rooms Total for a 2 night stay -

- 4 rooms for Men's Varsity Wrestling (4 wrestlers per room)
- 4 rooms for Women's Varsity Wrestling (4 wrestlers per room)
- 4 rooms for Stat Crew (4 stat crew per room)
- 3 rooms for coaches (2 coaches per room)
- 1 room for driver

Room Rate: 99.90

16 Rooms at \$99.90 per night (2 nights)

Total Lodging Cost = \$3,996

\*\*Price may decrease depending on the number of stat crew attending. We average 12 members attending the trip but have brought as few as 9 and as many as 16. Super 8 will allow us to drop unnecessary rooms.

### Transportation:

Blue Star Charters: 269.88 miles traveled last trip. We will be wrestling at Crook County High School on Thursday evening which has added 44 total miles to this event.

56 person charter bus - All students and 3 coaches will travel as a team from Gresham to Redmond. Entire teams and staff travel on the bus during the different sessions.

### Food:

Athletes will purchase food at the Safeway. We instruct students to bring money to purchase their own food based on their family needs and family situation. Families who cannot afford to purchase food are sponsored by wrestling alumni. In addition we coordinate with parents and coaches to supply food at the tournament and pack a cooler for the tournament.

**Total Estimated Cost = \$\$9,988**
