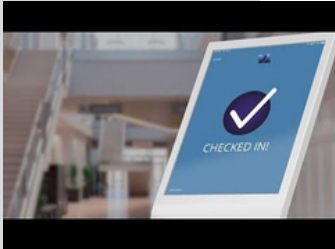

SECURITY UPDATES FOR UNITY SCHOOL DISTRICT: VISITOR MANAGEMENT

THE SAFETY AND WELL-BEING OF STUDENTS AND STAFF ARE ALWAYS OF THE UTMOST IMPORTANCE FOR UNITY SCHOOL DISTRICT. ONE OF THE PRIMARY FACTORS IMPACTING SAFETY IS VISITOR MANAGEMENT AND MAINTAINING A SECURE CAMPUS.

OVER THE PAST EIGHT YEARS, THE DISTRICT HAS UTILIZED A PROGRAM CALLED RAPTORWARE FOR VISITOR MANAGEMENT. DURING THAT TIME, MANY STRIDES HAVE BEEN MADE IN VISITOR MANAGEMENT SYSTEMS FOR SCHOOL DISTRICTS. AS A RESULT, UNITY HAS PARTNERED WITH A COMPANY CALLED SINGLEWIRE TO UPGRADE THE VISITOR MANAGEMENT SYSTEM TO A NEW PROGRAM CALLED VISITOR AWARE. IN THE COMING WEEKS, IMPORTANT INFORMATION WILL BE SHARED WITH FAMILIES AND COMMUNITY MEMBERS TO UNDERSTAND NEW PROCEDURES, HOW TO ACCESS THE NECESSARY RESOURCES, AND WHOM PEOPLE CAN CONTACT WITH ANY SPECIFIC QUESTIONS. WHILE THERE ARE MANY ADVANTAGES TO THIS CHANGE, THE PRIMARY ADVANTAGE WILL BE THE EASE OF USE AND ASSURANCE OF SAFETY FOR STUDENTS AND STAFF!

COMMUNITY TASK FORCE MEETINGS WRAP-UP

On the evening of Monday, June 22nd, the fourth and final Community Task Force Committee Meeting was held in the HS Library. During the meeting, district leadership and task force members discussed priorities for a potential referendum. The primary priority areas that the task force members identified using a prioritization tool included new and updated CTE facilities, replacing high-priority roofs, addressing parking lots and the pick-up and drop-off lane in front of the schools, FCE and culinary arts, updating the kitchen and cafeteria areas, and renovating outdoor athletics facilities in order to ensure ADA accessibility, improve public parking access, and provide much-needed updates. Community Task Force members will work with Kraus-Anderson and District Administration to present their recommendations to the Board of Education during the July Board meeting on Monday, July 13th.
