Agenda Item Title: 2026-2027 South San Antonio ISD Pay and Compensation Plan

From/Presenters: Rita Uresti, Executive Director of Human Resources

Description: The 2026-2027 Pay and Compensation Plan contains all pay scales, pay ranges, and stipends for each and every position within the District. The 2026-2027 pay and compensation plan is fundamental in supporting the vision, goals and operations of the district to recruit and retain highly qualified staff to promote positive student outcomes.

Historical Data: During the 2025–2026 school year, the South San Antonio ISD Board approved compensation increases in accordance with the 89th Texas Legislature's House Bill 2 (HB 2). The salary adjustments provided increases for most employee groups. House Bill 2 is a comprehensive Texas public school finance law that provides significant new funding to support educator compensation, address teacher shortages, and strengthen public education across the state.

Recommendation: Approve the 2026-2027 South San Antonio ISD Pay and Compensation Plan as presented.

During the 2026-2027 implementation year, the Campus Professional Administrator Compensation Plan will apply only to administrators assigned to campuses that received an A or B rating. Campus administrators who are new to their position or new to the campus will have their first year salary determined by the Human Resources Department based on review of professional experience, internal salary equity, and other compensatory factors. Beginning in the second year on implementation, administrators hired who have received an evaluation under the applicable administrator appraisal system (T-PESS, Attendance & Student Outcomes), will have their compensation determined by their earned effectiveness level. Administrators who receive a lower evaluation rating for two consecutive years, based on their effectiveness level will have their salary reduced to correspond to their effectiveness level. All salaries reflected on this schedules represent annual compensation for 100% full-time equivalent (FTE) assignment and apply only to the 2026-2027 school year.
