Agenda Item Caption: Consideration of Memorandum of Understanding with Central Counties Services for the 2026-2027 School Year

Purpose of Agenda Item: Action needed

Administrative Recommendation: Move to approve the Memorandum of Understanding with Central Counties Services for the 2026-2027 school year, as presented, and to delegate signature authority to the Superintendent or designee.

Background Information: Central Counties Services (CCS) was created pursuant to the Texas Mental Health and Mental Retardation Act of 1965 and operates a comprehensive community mental health and intellectual disability center for persons in the counties of Bell, Coryell, Hamilton, Lampasas, and Milam.

CCS provides a range of services for persons experiencing symptoms of mental illness, provides outpatient mental health services to children, and maintains an outpatient clinic for that purpose at 110 East Avenue A, in Killeen, Texas.

KISD and CCS enter into this Memorandum of Understanding for the purpose of allowing CCS personnel to provide child mental health services on KISD campuses for KISD students who are clients of CCS. The term of this MOU is September 1, 2026 to August 31, 2027.
