Recommendations:

This year, the SHAC focused on topics listed below:

- Increase parent education for Smart Badge and Parent Square
- Increased male guardian and father participation on campus
- Re-evaluation of the puberty video used for 4th-grade.

Committee Recommendations

- Recommend the use of informational posters with QR codes at the campus front office to educate about the Smart Badge system.
- Recommend the use of informational posters with QR codes at the campus front offices to provide education on Parent Square.
- Recommend that Mansfield ISD encourage principals to boost male guardian involvement by partnering with programs such as All Pro Dads across all campuses.
- Suggest that the next SHAC Committee review the current puberty video used for 4th-grade.

Physical Activity and Fitness Planning Committee Recommendations

Recommendations from committee:

- Continue to recommend the district encourage principals to implement 150 minutes a week of unstructured free play for grades PK-4th.
- Collect data from the 9 elementary campuses that participated in increased unstructured free play in the 25/26 school year.
