



**RECOMMENDATION TO APPROVE
ADDITION OF STUDENT ACCOUNTABILITY
CAMPUS MONITOR
July 15, 2026**

The District has created a new position titled Student Accountability Campus Monitor. This position is responsible for monitoring students and promoting a safe, secure, and orderly school environment by maintaining a visible presence throughout the high school building, grounds, facilities, and parking lots. The Student Accountability Campus Monitor will observe student behavior, help ensure compliance with school expectations, respond to safety and security concerns, and support the overall supervision of students during the school day and at other times as determined by building administration. This position will be included as a part of the Educational Support Professionals' (ESP) bargaining agreement, as provided in the attached Memorandum of Understanding (MOU)

The District previously contracted for parking lot monitoring and related campus security services. The new Student Accountability Campus Monitor position is intended to expand those services by providing supervision and monitoring both inside the high school building and throughout the campus. As a result, the District will discontinue the contracted parking lot monitoring and security services.

Administration recommends approval of the MOU to add the Student Accountability Campus Monitor position to the ESP Master Agreement.
