

Denton ISD Registration Information 2013-14

Pre-Kindergarten

- In-Person Registration for all district Pre-K Programs (Free and Academy) will take place on August 1 and 2 (Thursday and Friday) at the ATC. Parents will need to bring the following:
 - All families:
 - Official Birth Certificate
 - Immunization Record
 - Proof of Residency (current utility bill, lease agreement, etc.)
 - Additionally, those who wish to be considered for free Pre-K should bring:
 - Evidence of income – pay stubs or other documentation **from the past month**, SNAP Card, proof of current military dependency, etc.
 - Families who wish to participate in Academy (tuition-based) Pre-K should be prepared to make a deposit and initial payment. (Tuition)

- Financial eligibility will be reviewed / determined during this event. Language screening will be available at the event for students to determine eligibility based upon home language. Representatives from all campuses offering Pre-K will be available for this registration day. **Families who have provided all required documentation will leave knowing the eligibility status of their student and the school that their child will attend.**

- **For those who wish to register for Pre-Kindergarten following the August 1-2 dates:**
 - Parents should bring the above listed information with them to the campus where they hope to enroll their child for 2013-14.
 - If space is not available on the desired campus, families will be referred to other campuses where space is available.

Kindergarten Registration

- All elementary campuses will host Pre-Registration sessions for parents of 2013-14 kindergarteners on Wednesday, May 8. Sessions will be scheduled for 9:00 – 10:00 a.m. and 1:30 – 2:30 p.m.
- Campus computer labs will be available to facilitate ease of enrollment.
- Parents will complete the entry of their child's basic information into eSchool. Trained campus staff will be available to assist with this process.
- Parents will provide the following documents:
 - Official Birth Certificate
 - Immunization Record
 - Proof of Residency
- On or around July 1, parents will receive an email from Denton ISD / InfoSnap. This email will provide parents with an exclusive SnapCode that will allow the parent to log into their child's registration site. Parents will verify the pre-populated information that they provided on May 8, make any necessary changes, and complete the registration process. Among the items that will be completed online will be the health information card, food allergy information, emergency contact information, permission for various levels of publicity / privacy, field trip permission form, electronic signature receipt for on-line Student Code of Conduct, and others. Links will also be available for parents to complete the Free/Reduced Lunch Application, Transportation Services Application, and to enroll for Ready Rosie videos.
- Parents will need to provide current proof of residency (current utility bill, lease agreement, etc.) to their campus beginning August 5. This may be provided in person, via fax, or scanned and emailed. Campuses will be open all day during posted district work hours – including lunch – to accept this verification.
- Parents of students who are currently enrolled in Denton ISD pre-kindergarten and who will be attending a Denton ISD kindergarten in the fall will not have to complete this process. They will receive an email with registration update information in the summer.

2013-14 Returning Students (1st through 12th Graders)

- On or around July 1, parents will receive an email from Denton ISD / InfoSnap. This email will provide parents with an exclusive SnapCode that will allow the parent to log into their child's registration site. Parents will verify the pre-populated information, make any necessary changes, and complete the registration process. Among the items that will be completed online will be the health information card, emergency contact information, permission for various levels of publicity / privacy, field trip permission form, electronic signature receipt for on-line Student Code of Conduct, and others. Forms provided will be customized for elementary / secondary students. Links will also be available for parents to complete the Free/Reduced Lunch Application, Transportation Services Application, and to enroll for Ready Rosie videos.
- Elementary parents will need to provide current proof of residency (current utility bill, lease agreement, etc.) to their campus beginning August 5. This may be provided in person, via fax, or scanned and emailed. Campuses will be open all day – including lunch – to accept this verification.
- Secondary parents will need to provide current proof of residency (current utility bill, lease agreement, etc.) to their campus during posted business days.

2013-2014 New to Denton ISD Students – 1st through 12th Grades

- Parents will complete the entry of their child's basic information into eSchool – either remotely or utilizing a school computer. Trained campus staff will be available to assist with this process.
- Parents will provide required documents, which may include (depending upon grade level):
 - Official Birth Certificate
 - Immunization Record
 - Proof of Residency
 - Last report card or records from previous district
- Parents will receive an email from Denton ISD / InfoSnap. This email will provide parents with an exclusive SnapCode that will allow the parent to log into their child's registration site. Parents will verify the pre-populated information that they provided earlier, make any necessary changes, and complete the registration process. Among the items that will be completed online will be the health information card, food allergy information, emergency contact information, permission for various levels of publicity / privacy, field trip permission form, electronic signature receipt for on-line Student Code of Conduct, and others. Forms provided will be customized for elementary / secondary students. Links will also be available for parents to complete the Free/Reduced Lunch Application, Transportation Services Application, and to enroll for Ready Rosie videos.
