### **Background Information**

Duncanville ISD routinely reviews enrollment trends, facility utilization, and program needs to ensure district resources are aligned with providing strong learning environments for all students. Alexander Elementary has experienced sustained low enrollment in recent years, resulting in the campus operating significantly below its intended capacity. In addition, the District has observed increased student mobility within the Alexander attendance zone, which has contributed to inconsistent enrollment patterns and challenges in maintaining long-term program stability.

After reviewing these factors—including declining enrollment, facility efficiency, resource allocation, and student mobility—the administration is recommending that Alexander Elementary be transitioned from its current instructional use and that the District begin planning for future utilization of the campus. This approach allows the District to better align resources across campuses while ensuring that students continue to receive high-quality educational opportunities within Duncanville ISD.

### **Recommendation**

It is recommended that the Board of Trustees approve the transition of Alexander Elementary School from its current instructional use at the conclusion of the 2025–2026 school year to a district storage facility and authorize the administration to implement a comprehensive transition plan.
