### **World Class Education**

- Mrs. Engh worked on rolling over the calendar in Infinite Campus so Mrs. Tucci will be able to start getting High School students registered for classes in campus.
- We have a math teacher for next year!
- Posting for a High School Special Education Teacher is still posted and waiting applications.
- Completed all MCAs
- Working with IASC again for a continued internship program next school year.
- Discussed briefly with the Ambulance Director, Katie Foy, about ways to provide education around the volunteer ambulance programs and provide possible high school credit for students that take their training.
- In communication with many curriculum providers to find what would be best for FHS and fit within budget. Math is looking promising and ELA is expensive, but we may be able to purchase it in stages.

### **Safe and Nurturing Environment**

- Celebrated our teachers/staff, school nurse and lunch heroes this month with a week of treats and small gifts.

- The week of May 11th, NHS recognized Mental Health Week. Staff showed their support with Mental Health Awareness shirts on Monday and throughout the week the announcements gave students daily challenges. NHS also presented to the student body in small groups based on grade level on Mental Health.
- Completed all required safety drills for this school year with our final fire drill on Friday, May 15th.
- Reviewing the Crisis Manual for any changes needed for the next school year.
- Met with the Wellness Committee on 5/11 and Mrs. Kozumplik shared the Floodwood specific Cardiac Emergency Plan that will be added to our Crisis binders for the new school year.
- Softball and baseball teams are taking an AED out to practice and games as directed by Mr. Bartsch the AD.
- Check-ins with students regularly
- Ms. Tucci and I continue to meet with students, parents and staff to help with different situations to help students feel safe and welcome.
- Working with the local EMR and Maria Manner on finding a date at the start of the year in service for First Aid/CPR/AED training for all staff.

### **Opportunities for Students**

- Many field trips are planned for the last part of the school year. Children's Museum, Hibbing Historical Museum, Rust Hill Mineview, Traditional 6th grade field trip, MacRostie Art Center.
- Summer baseball/softball has begun. We have Tball, machine pitch and little league baseball started with practices. We also have some elementary students going over to Cromwell to play softball.
- Five different professionals came to the school 5/13 to present to our high school classes. The five professions represented were: Tattoo artist, Social Worker, Lawyer, Human Resource Generalist, and MN DOT workers.

### **Fund a 21st Century Education**

- FHS was granted a \$5,000 grant from the Nibbe Family Foundation. This grant is earmarked for literacy - specifically to update and add to our 4-12th grade classroom libraries. 4th grade - \$1000, 5th grade - \$1000, 6th grade - \$1000 and 7-12th grade - \$2,000. This check will be here soon and we will wait until fall to purchase new books due to the construction.
