

Union Grove Elementary 2026-27 Grading Policy

- Teachers should grade students' papers in a timely manner.
- Grades should be posted at least weekly in Skyward.
- To demonstrate mastery in a subject, a student must achieve an average of 70% or higher on a combination of daily work, projects, classroom performance, and tests related to the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS) and any additional district curriculum requirements.
- Teachers may allow students to redo assignments or make corrections; however, the highest possible grade on a redone/corrected assignment is 60.
- Any student caught cheating or engaging in academic dishonesty will receive a **zero (0)** on the assignment or assessment. Additional disciplinary action may be taken as outlined in campus and district policies.
- When students return from an absence, they have one day for each day of absence to turn in any work they missed. If students ask for and receive the work they will need prior to/during the absence, the work is due when the student returns from the absence. Exceptions may be made and will be determined by the campus administrator.
- Teachers in grades 1-6 must record a minimum of ten grades per content area during each nine-week grading period.
- Elementary teachers weigh all grades equally. Weights are not assigned according to daily work, projects, tests, etc. However, teachers have the option of recording some assignments more than once.
