School Philosophy:

The Homedale School District believes that students should be provided with the basic skills to develop physically, intellectually, socially, emotionally, and spiritually. The educational program is designed to enable students to be productive in the community, state, nation, and world.

Statement of Purpose:

The Homedale School District's goal is to provide quality education for all students. Partnership between parents, community, and school is the key factor contributing to student success and achievement.

Parental Involvement in Policy Development:

A Title 1 parental advisory committee, consisting of six parents, one teacher from each Title 1 school in the district, a principal, the project director, and the home school coordinator, will meet to develop and review the district's Title 1 Involvement Policy.

Support and Structure Development for Strong Parental Involvement:

- * Schedule an annual meeting to inform Title 1 parents of their school's participation in the programs, program requirements, and their right to be involved in these programs.
- * Keep parents informed about their child's academic progress, assessment results, curriculum used in school, and expected proficiency levels.
- * Provide, if needed, transportation and child care for parents, to encourage attendance at meetings related to parental involvement.
- * Involve parents in the planning, reviewing, and improvement of educational Title 1 programs.
- * Provide parents with specific instructional strategies that align with classroom goals to assist their child at home.

- * Require each school site to plan and effectively implement a parental involvement plan.
- * Provide Title 1 schools with a model parent/school contract, which outlines how parents, school staff, and students will share in the responsibility for improving student achievement. The school district and parents whose children attend school in the district will be provided with the means to build and develop a partnership that will help children achieve high standards.
- * Conduct an annual evaluation to review the effectiveness of the parental involvement policy.

Evaluation:

An evaluation that includes parental input will be conducted annually. It will focus on the content and effectiveness of the Title 1 Parental Involvement program. Its goal will be to evaluate parental involvement programs in the district by collecting information in a variety of ways, such as visits to school and securing written comments from parents and teachers.

The annual evaluation will include an assessment of parental involvement in schools and identify barriers to parental participation. Results of the evaluation will be shared with the Title 1 staff and will serve as a guide in future goal setting and revision of the Parental Involvement Policy.
