2026-2027 District Dress Code

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General Standards

Previous Version

Prohibited tight, revealing, sagging, or baggy clothing

Pajamas and slippers prohibited

Prohibited offensive messages and symbols

Revised Version

Expanded language to include “excessively loose,” “immodest,” and see-through clothing

Added bedroom attire, beach sandals, pool shoes, trench coats, and duster coats

Added gang references and broader disruptive language



Shirts and Tops

Previous Version

Oversized shirts prohibited

Bare midriff prohibited

Boys' cut-off shirts prohibited

Revised Version

Defined oversized shirts as extending below wrists

Expanded to prohibit bare shoulders, backs, chests, and midriffs

Added open-arm shirts prohibition



Pants / Shorts / Dresses

Previous Version

Fingertip length standard for shorts/skirts

Shorts could not be rolled (not specified previously)

Leggings/jeggings required coverage

Boys wearing skirts/dresses not addressed

Revised Version

Same standard maintained

Added rolled shorts prohibition

Same requirement maintained

Explicitly prohibited



Footwear

Previous Version

House shoes/slippers prohibited

Revised Version

Added flip-flops, pool shoes, beach sandals, and steel-toe boots (unless approved for a need/class)



Hair and Grooming

Previous Version

Hair could not be disruptive

Facial hair allowed if groomed

No eyebrow shaved lines

No restrictions on hair color

Male hair length not specified

Male ponytails not addressed

Makeup/nail polish not addressed

Revised Version

Added detailed grooming restrictions

Facial hair fully prohibited

Expanded to include Mohawks, geometric designs, and unusual patterns

Unnatural hair colors prohibited

Specific male hair length requirements added

Male ponytails prohibited

Male makeup and nail polish prohibited



Head Coverings / Face Coverings

Previous Version

Hats/head coverings prohibited

Hoods prohibited indoors

Face coverings allowed with limitations

Revised Version

Similar language maintained

Same requirement maintained

Added language prohibiting intentional concealment of identity except for medical, religious, or cultural reasons



Jewelry / Piercings / Tattoos

Previous Version

Male students allowed limited earrings

Single nostril piercing allowed

Tattoos only restricted if disruptive/offensive

Gauges prohibited

Grills prohibited

Revised Version

Male earrings completely prohibited

All visible body piercings except ears prohibited

All tattoos and skin drawings must be covered

Maintained

Maintained



Key Differences Between Old and New Versions

<u>Area</u>	<u>Previous Policy</u>	<u>Revised Policy</u>
Hair Color	Allowed unless disruptive	Unnatural colors prohibited
Male Earrings	Limited stud allowed	Completely prohibited
Facial Hair	Allowed if groomed	Completely prohibited
Tattoos	Only offensive tattoos restricted	All tattoos must be covered
Gender Expression	Less restrictive	More gender-specific restrictions
Footwear	General restrictions	Specific prohibited footwear listed
Face Coverings	Limited guidance	Detailed clarification added
