Transportation Report - July 15, 2026

Transportation Updates:

- Becky Craig-Johnson took 2nd Place at the State Bus Rodeo
- We are working diligently to close out all of our year end reports for the state.
- We are currently training 3 sub drivers for next school year.
- We are heading to Boise for the state's Train the Trainer convention.
- The mechanics are doing inspections and tuning up the fleet over the summer. This includes an assessment of the conditions/mileage of the buses to determine what the fleet will look like next year and what buses may need to be replaced.

- We have changed the verbiage for our Procedures and Rules on the Trip sheets we use in hopes that we will not have a repeated situation like we did at the end of last school year. We added verbiage to the existing categories of:
 - Chaperones & Coaches Responsibilities:
 - To ensure all passengers follow bus rules, Chaperones/Coaches should be placed in the back and front of the bus during rides to and from their destinations, if multiple Chaperones/Coaches are present. In the case where there are only 1 Chaperone/Coach, they should position themselves in the middle of the bus.
 - Evacuation Procedures:
 - Location & use of all emergency exits are only to be used in an emergency and/or with the drivers permission.
- The following verbiage was added to the Procedures and Rules:
 - To ensure the safety of all students, chaperones/coaches and the drivers, all rules will be followed to and from destinations. Any infraction of these rules, will be met with a write up warning or privileges revoked from future rides. If privileges get revoked, students will have to self transport to any event thereafter. Each infraction, depending on the severity, will be dealt with on a case by case basis and with the discretion of the Transportation Director. Please remember, riding the bus is a privilege not a right.
