7. New Business

7.1. College & Career Readiness Committee Updates

- The committee reviewed projects that are currently in the process of being worked on for school board members new to the committee. These projects include:
 - Opening Door Survey: The district is currently working with School Perceptions to provide a survey to our outgoing 5th and 8th grade students to determine what support they need to successfully transition to middle school and high school, especially in the area of CTE.
 - Concurrent Enrollment Courses: The district has been working with UW-Milwaukee and UW-Green Bay to offer college level courses, English 101 and Precalculus, to our students. Students will receive college credit for completing the course and are eligible for a \$1,000 scholarship if they attend UW-Milwaukee or UW-Green Bay for college.
 - Reduced Credit Pathway: The district's On-Track to Graduation Committee is currently considering adopting this pathway for students who would benefit from it but are interested in an in-person school option.

7.2. Exploring a Partnership with West Allis Farmers Market

- The committee discussed reaching out to the West Allis Farmers Market and the City of West Allis to discuss a possible partnership with the district.

7.3. McGraw Hill Update

- The committee learned that the quote provided to the district for the Social Studies curriculum adoption was incorrect. The amount quoted to the district only included the students included in the pilot study and not all of our secondary students. The new quote is for \$451,843, which is \$271,642 more than initially quoted. The board will be asked to approve this additional amount to adopt the curriculum.
