Topic

Approval of Coolidge Water Main Repairs

Recommendation

Move that the Board of Education of the Livonia Public Schools School District approve the recommendation from the Owner's Representative, Plante Moran Realpoint, to proceed with the water main replacement at Coolidge Elementary School in the amount of \$220,938, plus \$34,062 in contingency, for a total project cost of \$255,000. We further authorize the Superintendent or her designee to negotiate and execute the final contract with the recommended contractor, D'Angelo Brothers Inc., Farmington Hills, Michigan.

Rationale

The water main at Coolidge Elementary School requires replacement to prevent significant future issues and ensure reliable operation of the building's water system.
