Food Service Building Report

The Food Service Program total meals served to students for March 2026 are below (18 days of meals)

Breakfast: 15,710 meals

Lunches: 21,623 meals

Supper Program: 701 meals

The Food Service Program is in the process of completing the School Nutrition Program (SNP) for Breakfast/Lunch for SY 2027-2028.

The Summer Food Service Program's (SFSP) application has been approved for meal service for 2026-2027. The SFSP flyers will coming out soon via social media, public postings, and the Pioneer Press. The SFSP program will start on June 8th.

The kitchens started an end of school year freezer/cooler clear-out on May 19th to avoid any waste or spoilage. At this time, we clear all food items out of the coolers/freezers in all kitchens and the food service warehouse.

The Supper Program ends for the school year on May 22nd and will resume September 1, 2026. The Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP) has approved the Supper Program's application for the upcoming school year.

The Ware house has been working very hard daily to carry out their daily operations including the assistance they provide for the school kitchens, food deliveries, and mail. And, the warehouse clerks have started arranging/organizing the warehouse for the upcoming Summer Food Service Program (SFSP).

The food service program does have vacancies; (2) assistant cooks at Napi, (1) head cook at Napi kitchen, (1) assistant cook at Bullshoe, (1) assistant cook at BES.

The County Sanitarian has recently completed the Food Establishment Inspections for all kitchens on April 14, 2026

At this time, the copy center clerk has been extremely busy with copy orders in preparing for the upcoming events, and getting orders complete. And, copy center is getting ready for the upcoming summer season and the printing orders for the new school year.

The food service program looks forward to feeding the kids and happy tummies!
