

**RESOLUTION DECLARING 2615 VIRGINIA STREET, BAYTOWN, TEXAS AS
SURPLUS REAL PROPERTY**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 11.151(a) of the Texas Education Code the Board of Trustees (the “Board”) of Goose Creek Consolidated Independent School District (the “District”) is authorized to hold real property on behalf of the District; and

WHEREAS, the Board is vested with the exclusive power and duty to govern and oversee the management of the public schools of the District; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 11.151(c) of the Texas Education Code the Board is given the authority to dispose of property that is no longer necessary for the operation of the District; and

WHEREAS, the Board holds the property located at 2615 Virginia Street, Baytown, Texas 77520, being a 3.34 acre tract of land in the East Baytown Subdivision of Harris County, Texas (the “Property”) on behalf of the District; and

WHEREAS, the Property was previously the site of San Jacinto Elementary prior to its relocation to 2700 Market Street, Baytown, Texas; and

WHEREAS, given the size and condition of the improvements located on the Property and the relocation of San Jacinto Elementary, the Board has determined that the Property is no longer needed for the educational purposes or the operation of the District; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that it is in the best interest of the District to dispose of the Property in a manner that serves a public purpose; and

WHEREAS, the District will comply with Section 11.1542 of the Texas Education Code;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE GOOSE CREEK CONSOLIDATED INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT:

RESOLVED, the Board finds that the Property is no longer needed for the educational purposes or the operation of the District; and

RESOLVED, the District will comply with Section 11.1542 of the Texas Education Code; and

RESOLVED, that the Board authorizes and directs the Superintendent or his designee to take all necessary steps to comply with Section 11.1542 of the Texas Education Code; and

RESOLVED, that should no suitable bids be received pursuant to Section 11.1542 of the Texas Education Code, then the Superintendent is authorized and directed to engage in discussions with other governmental entities for use of the Property for a public purpose.
