RE: Approval of South Campus Electronic Door Access

STAFF RECOMMENDATION: That the Board approves the purchase of equipment and installation services for the South Campus Electronic Door Access project in the amount of \$286,428.00. The equipment and services for this project will be procured through the vendor Computer Solutions using the contract OMNIA EV2370.

BACKGROUND: This project included the door access panel, Bluetooth card readers, door hardware, cabling, labor, and programming for implementing an electronic door access system. The benefits of an electronic door access solution include remote door management, audit trails of after-hours access, and instant credential revocation for lost cards or when an employee separates. The system will also allow our campus police department to lock all exterior doors of the south campus building at the click of a button during emergency situations.

BUDGETARY CONSIDERATIONS: The cost of the equipment and installation services is \$286,428.00 and will be paid using a line item allocated in the Information Technology department budget that was approved as part of FY 26 equipment purchases.
