

Workforce Division Monthly Board Report

May 2026

Summary/Overview

In the annual academic timeline, May is when we are preparing for the start of summer classes. We are finalizing our Fall schedule and planning our summer projects.

The Safety Training Center (STC) continues to provide required safety training to the Northern Panhandle Region. The technicians assigned to work at the various plants and refineries cannot do so until they receive the training and subsequent STC documentation. This is a critical mission which supports the regional workforce. The STC has been down two full-time positions nearly the entire month of May, and that will likely be the case for the month of June as well.

Business and Industry Partners Served

This month the Safety Training Center served 30 regional business and industry partners.

Individuals Served

This month we delivered over 500 courses to over 350 individuals.

Total Monthly Revenues

This month we reported a total of \$20,506 in gross revenues. This represents 16 training days (and a strong gross revenue) for the month of May.
