

**AMENDMENT TO INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN  
DUPO COMMUNITY UNIT SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 196  
AND THE VILLAGE OF DUPO  
FOR SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER SERVICES**

**This Amendment to the Intergovernmental Agreement**, by and between the Board of Education of Dupo Community Unit School District No. 196, County of St. Clair, State of Illinois (hereinafter “the District”) and the Village of Dupo, County of St. Clair, State of Illinois (hereinafter “the Village”)(hereinafter collectively referred to as “the Parties”), provides:

**WITNESSETH:**

**WHEREAS**, the Parties mutually desire to amend and clarify the terms of the Intergovernmental Agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, both the District and the Village are authorized to enter into intergovernmental agreements pursuant to Article VII, § 10 of the Constitution of the State of Illinois and the provisions of the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act, 5 ILCS 220/1, *et seq.*; and

**WHEREAS**, the District and the Village have mutually determined that it would be in the best interest of the safety and welfare of students and employees of the District to amend the Intergovernmental as described below.

**NOW THEREFORE**, in consideration of the premises and the mutual promises and covenants herein contained, the Board of Education of Dupo Community Unit School District No. 196, and the Village of Dupo, do hereby agree as follows:

The parties agree to the following modifications to the Agreement:

**III. TERM OF AGREEMENT**

B. **Contract Extension**: The parties agree that at the expiry of the Initial Term or any subsequent renewed term, this Agreement shall automatically renew for an additional one (1) year term on the same terms and conditions as contained in this Agreement, unless written notice is given by one party to the other parties of its intention not to renew the Agreement. Said non renew notice must be received by the other party on or before May 1st of the Initial Term or any Subsequent renewed term. After, and if, this Agreement is automatically renewed five (5) years consecutively, this Agreement shall automatically expire at the end of the 5th renewal term.

Prior to an extension of this Agreement, the District shall obtain community and stakeholder input on the School Resource Officer program. The Parties shall then meet prior to renewal to conduct a review and evaluation of the School Resource Officer program, considering any community and stakeholder input.

**V. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE VILLAGE AND POLICE DEPARTMENT**

D. **Training**: The Police Department shall enroll School Resource Officers in all necessary training for law enforcement officers pursuant to the Illinois Police Training Act, 50 ILCS 705, and the Illinois Law Enforcement Training and Standards Board policies and procedures, in order to carry a firearm and live ammunition while on duty, and shall receive renewal trainings required to maintain the foregoing certifications as well as such additional trainings as may later become required for Illinois school resource officers. Training shall include specific training on working with students with disabilities to ensure appropriate and effective interactions that support their educational and behavioral needs. The Police Department shall pay all costs associated with basic law enforcement and annual training courses.

The Police Department shall provide to the District a certification of completion by the School Resource Officer of the school resource officer training (and copies certifying completion of all renewal trainings). The District shall arrange to include the School Resource Officer in the Crisis Prevention Intervention (“CPI”) training it offers to its employees.

G. **Duties and Responsibilities of School Resource Officers:**

5. In accordance with the *Illinois School Code* Section 10-22.6 (105 ILCS 5/10-22.6), the School Resource Officer is prohibited from issuing tickets or citations for municipal code violations as a school-based disciplinary consequence and from issuing tickets for municipal code violations on school grounds during school hours or while taking school transportation.
6. At the monthly meetings between the School Resource Officer and District staff, the SRO and designated District staff will review and confirm documentation of the “referrals to law enforcement” as defined in *Illinois School Code* Section 2-3.206 (105 ILCS 5/2-3.206) made to and by the SRO to support the District’s disaggregated data reporting requirements under that Code section.
