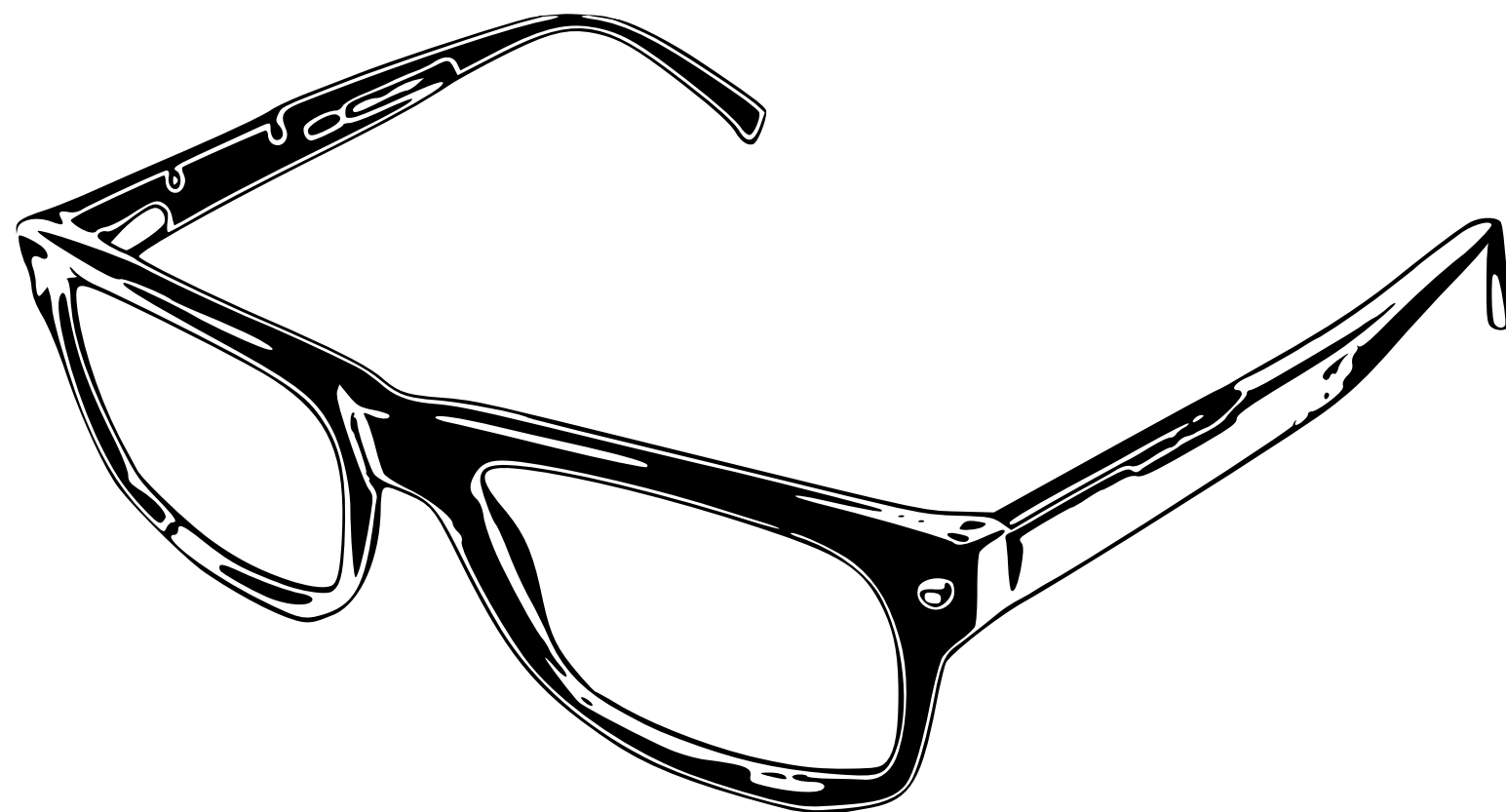


# PROHIBITED ITEMS

**Insulated metal cups or thermoses added to the list of prohibited items.**





**Headphones, earbuds, and AI glasses added to the examples of digital communication devices.**



## **PERSONAL COMMUNICATION DEVICES**

**Students shall not:**

**Use any login credentials other than their own, share passwords, or access another person's account.**

**Use personal USB drives, external hard drives, memory cards, or other personal storage devices with District equipment. All schoolwork shall be stored in District-managed cloud storage (OneDrive).**



## **MISUSE OF TECHNOLOGY RESOURCES AND THE INTERNET**

**The student discipline consequences have been revised to state that students may receive consequences at the campus such as lunch detention, Saturday detention, ISS, OSS or DAEP placement for behavior incidents while riding the bus.**

**Students can also be placed on bus probation, suspended or permanently removed from the bus.**

**Campus administrator designated to make the DAEP placement decision.**

**Appeals will be made to the Executive Director for Grievances and Complaints and will follow Board Policy FNG(Local).**



## **DAEP PLACEMENT**

**Removed the requirement for hair and facial hair to be groomed**

**Removed trench coats as an example of clothing that is not allowable.**

**District issued ID's will be required for all students.**

**Standardized dress expectations removed.**



## **DRESS CODE**

**Horseplay, inappropriate language, and selling items on campus without permission are removed from the Minor Offenses.**

**General minor and specific minor offense comparison chart removed.**



# **PROGRESSIVE DISCIPLINE MATRIX**

**Policy requiring DAEP placement for fighting and assault removed.**

**Fighting and assault are defined in Exhibit E as a Serious Offense.**
