### **Food Service Building Report**

The Food Service Program total meals served to students for May 2026 are below (19 days of meals)

**Breakfast: 15,655 meals**

**Lunches: 22,357 meals**

**Supper Program: 179 meals**

The Food Service Program completed/Approved for the School Nutrition Program (SNP) for Breakfast/Lunch for SY 2027-2028.

The Summer Food Service Program's (SFSP) has been approved/granted the "No Kid Hungry" grant in the amount of \$3000 for meal service for 2026-2027. This grant will help assist in food cost/supplies for the Food bus/Food Mobile.

The Summer Food Service Program is in full swing at all meal service sites. There has been an increase in kids participating in the Summer Food program the in the first (2) weeks. The increase is at all sites; BES, Skate Park, and Food Bus. The Summer Food Program will also be providing meal service to the kids at Children's Day on July 8<sup>th</sup> and Indian Days on July 9<sup>th</sup> by the Museum area.

The Ware house has been working very hard daily to carry out their daily operations including the assistance they provide for the school kitchens, food deliveries, and mail.

The food service program does have vacancies; (2) assistant cooks at Napi, (1) head cook at Napi kitchen, (1) assistant cook at Bullshoe, (1) assistant cook at BES.

The County Sanitarian has recently completed the Food Establishment Inspections for all kitchens on April 14, 2026.

At this time, the copy center clerk is preparing for the upcoming events, and will soon be printing orders for the new school year.

The food service program looks forward to feeding the kids and happy tummies!
