Expedited Renewal of School Charter for Don Tyson School of Innovation expiring June 30, 2026

Assistant Commissioner Dr. Darrell Smith presented the panel with an accountability report for this school with its charter expiring on June 30, 2026. The Charter School Office recommended to the CAP that charter be renewed for 5 years.
