Re: Approval of a five-year agreement with World Wide Technology, paid in full, for the Lightspeed web filter package, ensuring comprehensive Children’s Internet Protection Act (CIPA) compliance for all student and staff devices.

This agreement ensures continued Children’s Internet Protection Act (CIPA) compliance through a five-year, fully funded partnership with World Wide Technology to deploy Lightspeed Systems web filtering package across all district devices purchased in our bond lifecycles.

Maintaining CIPA compliance ensures our eligibility for E-rate funding, allowing us to secure significant discounts on essential networking infrastructure.

The proposal from World Wide Technology was procured in accordance with Texas Education Code §44.031 through the district's membership with the TIPS Contract # 230504.

RECOMMENDATION: That the Coppell ISD Board of Trustees approve the proposal from World Wide Technology for the five year Lightspeed filtering package for a total cost not to exceed \$500,000.
