

**A RESOLUTION
OF THE BOARD OF REGENTS OF THE LEE COLLEGE DISTRICT
ADOPTING THE 2025 HARRIS COUNTY MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL
HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN**

WHEREAS, the Board of Regents of Lee College District recognizes the threat that natural and technological hazards pose to students, employees, visitors, property, infrastructure, and operations of the College; and

WHEREAS, Lee College District participated in the preparation of the 2025 Harris County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan in accordance with the federal Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000; and

WHEREAS, the 2025 Harris County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan has been approved by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and the Texas Division of Emergency Management (TDEM); and

WHEREAS, the Plan identifies mitigation goals, objectives, and actions intended to reduce long-term risk to people and property from the impacts of future disasters and emergencies; and

WHEREAS, adoption of the Plan demonstrates the Board's commitment to hazard mitigation, emergency preparedness, operational resilience, and the protection of College resources; therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEE COLLEGE BOARD OF REGENTS:

SECTION 1. The Board of Regents hereby adopts the 2025 Harris County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan. The Plan may be revised, edited, or amended following submission for review and approval by FEMA or TDEM without requiring subsequent adoption by the Board of Regents, provided such revisions pertain only to this planning cycle. Nothing herein relieves Lee College of the obligation to participate in future plan updates as required by applicable federal and state regulations.
