



Detail

The federal Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 requires participating jurisdictions and entities to adopt an approved Hazard Mitigation Plan to maintain eligibility for certain Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Hazard Mitigation Assistance grant programs.

Lee College participated as one of 42 planning partners in development of the 2025 Harris County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan. The plan evaluates hazards that may impact the College and surrounding community, including flooding, hurricanes, severe weather, extreme heat/cold, utility failures, hazardous materials incidents, public health emergencies, and other natural and technological hazards.

The plan identifies mitigation goals and strategies designed to reduce risks to people, property, infrastructure, and operations. The plan has been reviewed and approved by the Texas Division of Emergency Management (TDEM) and FEMA.

Adoption of the plan demonstrates Lee College's commitment to emergency preparedness, resilience, and long-term risk reduction while maintaining eligibility for FEMA hazard mitigation grant opportunities.
