Agenda Item: Consider Approval of Services Packages and Related Services from Region 10 ESC for 2026-2027

Summary:

This is an exclusive service contract which provides for specified services from Region 10 Education Service Center throughout the Terrell Independent School District. Based on past usage of programs by school districts and the input from administrators on the Administrative Services Advisory Committee (ASAC), this package has been tailored to best meet the needs of Region 10 ESC districts.

The package cost for TISD is estimated at **\$297,440.30** for the following memberships:

Additionally, Terrell ISD may receive specified services from Region 10 Education Service Center specific to Special Education. These services are estimated at **\$64,200.00** and include:
 Special Education Supports (estimated \$5,000), Direct Services
 for Adapted PE (estimated \$28,000),
 Direct Services for Orientation & Mobility (O&M) (estimated \$30,000), Video
 Conference (\$1,200),

The services identified in the table above will be provided during the **2026-2027** school year, beginning September 1, 2026, and will continue through August 31, 2027. Additional services not included in the Services Package from Region 10 are available on a cost-per-service basis, if needed.

Region 10 Registration for Training and Printed Materials (\$133,301.71)

The district has reviewed and placed a hold on services and will follow up with contract execution upon Board approval.
