# 2026 Summer Special Education Data Support Grant Application

To assist with the IEP review process to identify the necessary data elements to submit in the first or second PEIMS Attendance Submission, TEA will be making a one-time extra-duty stipend grant available to school systems.

To be eligible for the grant, school systems must have an enrollment of at least 50 students receiving special education services, based on the Fall 2025 PEIMS snapshot data. If the fiscal agent for a Shared Services Arrangement (SSA) has been tasked with this review by its members, but individual members have fewer than 50 special education students, the SSA is eligible to apply if the total number of students receiving special education services from all members is at least 50. The SSA fiscal agent will submit the application, and if awarded funds, will be responsible for determining stipend distribution and payment processing.



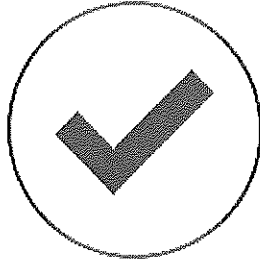
