

Student Code of Conduct Summary of Changes

Pg.16 – Language added at Appeals to clarify that campus discipline assignments such as detention or ISS are not appealable past the campus principal.

Pg. 21 – Retaliation added as an ISS offense.

Pg. 21 – Language added clarifying that ISS offense of violating technology use policies includes unauthorized cell phone and/or personal electronic device use.

Pg. 22 – At Process, language added that investigation could result in suspension pending investigation results.

Pg. 28 – Retaliation added as a discretionary DAEP placement offense.

Pg. 42 – Language added to clarify that felony marijuana and THC offenses are not mandatory expellable offenses under Chapter 37 of the Texas Education Code.

Secondary Honor Code

Language added clarifying that specific consequences will be applied upon the first offense when there is clear and compelling evidence of a student's academic dishonesty on a major grade.
