Agenda Topic: Memorandum of Understanding - HopSkipDrive

Guiding Outcome: Reciprocal Family & Community Partnerships

Summary: HopSkipDrive is a transportation ride service that provides transportation to Denton ISD students who have been identified through the McKinney-Vento Act as homeless or who are receiving services through foster care. Transportation is required for these students with transportation often being 1-way inter-district.

Background Information/  
Previous Board Action: This will be the second year to utilize HopSkipDrive services which has allowed Denton ISD to meet transportation requirements for students identified as homeless and/or in foster care.

Potential Operational Impact: This service will allow students to receive necessary transportation.

Potential Financial Impact: Approval allows Denton ISD to continue to meet requirements of the McKinney-Vento Act and to support at-risk populations.
